Remarks on board Tuesday October the 22nd 1861

Commenced with strong breezes from north east and raged within the sails employed in ordinary ship's duty had good weather through the night latter part fine breezes saw fin backs steering south by west 50 ends Leatt 18. 20 M Long 19. 05 W

Remarks on board Wednesday October the 23rd 1861

Commenced with fine breezes from north east and good within same. Drifters the watch employed looking out for water had fine breezes through the night at latter part fine weather clearing south by west nothing in sight 50 ends Leatt 18. 20 M Long 18. 50 W

Remarks on board Thursday October the 24th 1861

Commenced with light breezes from north west and good within same. Saw fin backs at sundown had light air from the northward latter part of the night at ten o'clock the boat for Blackfish and got two at half past eleven came on board latter part light breezes 50 ends no seal

Remarks on board Friday October the 25th 1861

Commenced with light breezes from the northward and good within the watch employed clearing away the Blackfish at three o'clock P.M. went for Blackfish and got four after chasing about an hour got two at sundown got along side and

Commenced with fine breezes from south west and good within the watch employed minding up the Makers at sundown reefed the mainsail latter part of the night had it calmer at ten o'clock P.M. got a light breeze from the eastward steered south west latter part fine weather 50 ends Leatt 18. 20 M Long 18. 50 W

Remarks on board Sunday October the 27th 1861

Commenced with light breezes from the eastward and fair within started the works and hoisted out the Blackfish fluke at sundown took in sail got three hoisting about seven o'clock P.M. had light air through the night at daylight made sail latter part light breezes steering south west 50 ends Leatt 18. 20 M Long 18. 40 W

Remarks on board Monday October the 28th 1861

Commenced with light breezes from the eastward and fair within at sundown took in sail had light breezes through the night and took in the at daylight turned the reef out of the topsail broke out and stowed down the Blackfish at latter part strong breezes reefed the topsail heading south west 50 ends Leatt 18. 20 M Long 19. 05 W
