

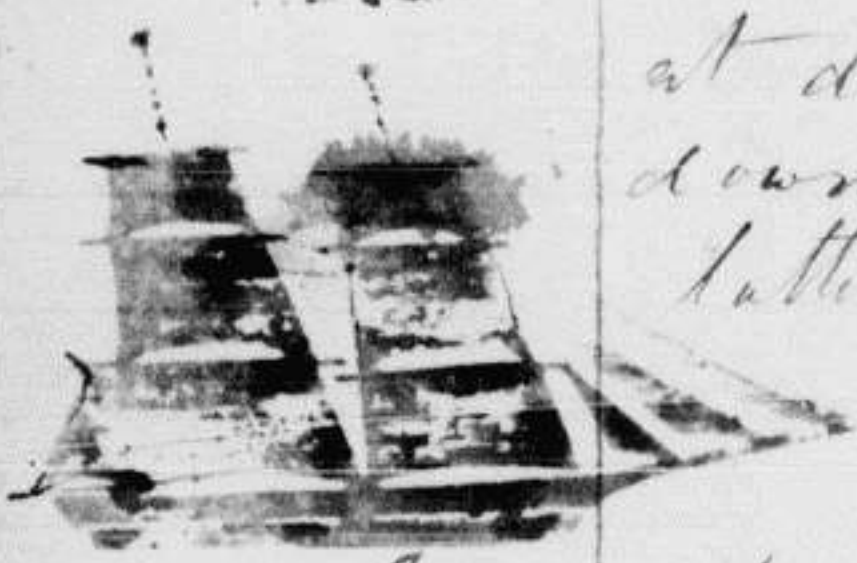

Had fair weather thru the night at nine o'clock it got more boisterous but had it calm and sail in sight so was not lost

Remarks on board Monday November the 4th 1861

Commenced with good weather but calm at fore which I got a light breeze from the northward heading to the eastward had good weather thru the night at daylight commenced backing out to starboard the oil was ship to the westward latter part fine weather so ends Log 9.37.00
Leaving 19.13.00



Remarks on board Tuesday November the 5th 1861

Commenced with fine breezes from the northward and good weather all hands employed in stowing down at five o'clock P.M. got stove up at sundown took in sail and ship to the eastward had fine weather thru the night at daylight backed off the ship at seven o'clock it was wind to the westward and made sail latter part fine weather nothing in sight so ends Log 9.37.00
Leaving 19.20.00

Remarks on board Wednesday November the 6th 1861

Commenced with fine breezes from north east and fair weather at fore which I got the boats for blackfish the starboard boat and main boat got fast the larboard boat got fast to a sand fish but lost him by the reins drawing at sundown took the blackfish on board one ran to the eastward and took in sail at twelve o'clock P.M. were ship to the northward at daylight made sail and stood on to the northward latter part fine weather saw large flocks of Porpoises so ends Log 10.00.00
Leaving 19.25.00

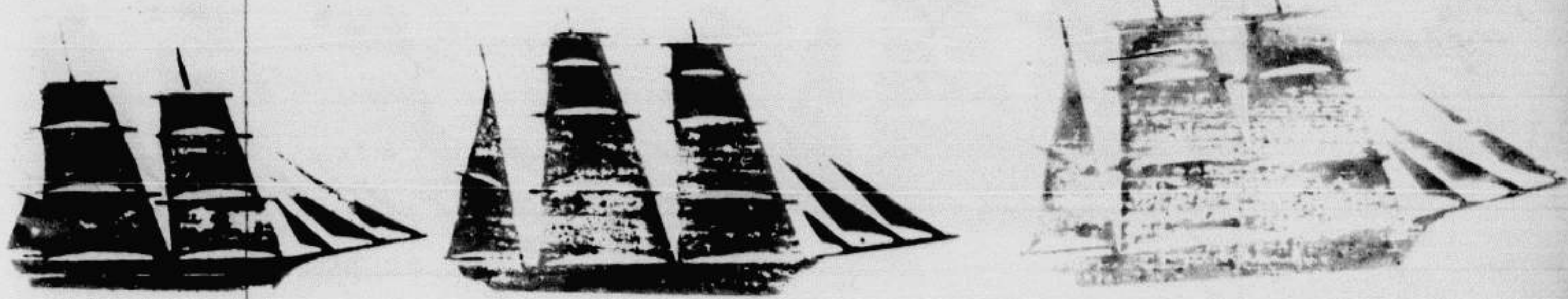

Remarks on board Thursday November the 7th 1861

Commenced with fine breezes from north east and fair weather saw finbacks the watch employed in mending ships decks at sundown took in sail heading north by the wind had fresh breezes thru the night at daylight made sail and looked ship to the eastward latter part fine weather nothing in sight so ends Log 9.57.00

Remarks on board Friday November the 8th 1861

Commenced with fine breezes from the northward and eastward and good weather left off south started the watch and hailed for the blackfish at three o'clock P.M. I went for blackfish but did not get any a sundown took in sail at one o'clock P.M. had a squall but a short haul an hour at daylight made sail saw two blackfish steering south west and a brig steering north west latter part fine weather steering south by night so ends Log 9.24.00
Leaving 20.00.00



Remarks on board Saturday November the 9th 1861

Commenced with light breezes from north east and fair weather the watch employed setting up the head stags at sundown took in sail had light breezes thru the night at daylight made sail looked for water and food latter part light breezes steering south by night so ends Log 9.44.00
