Remarks on board Wednesday February the 17th 1862

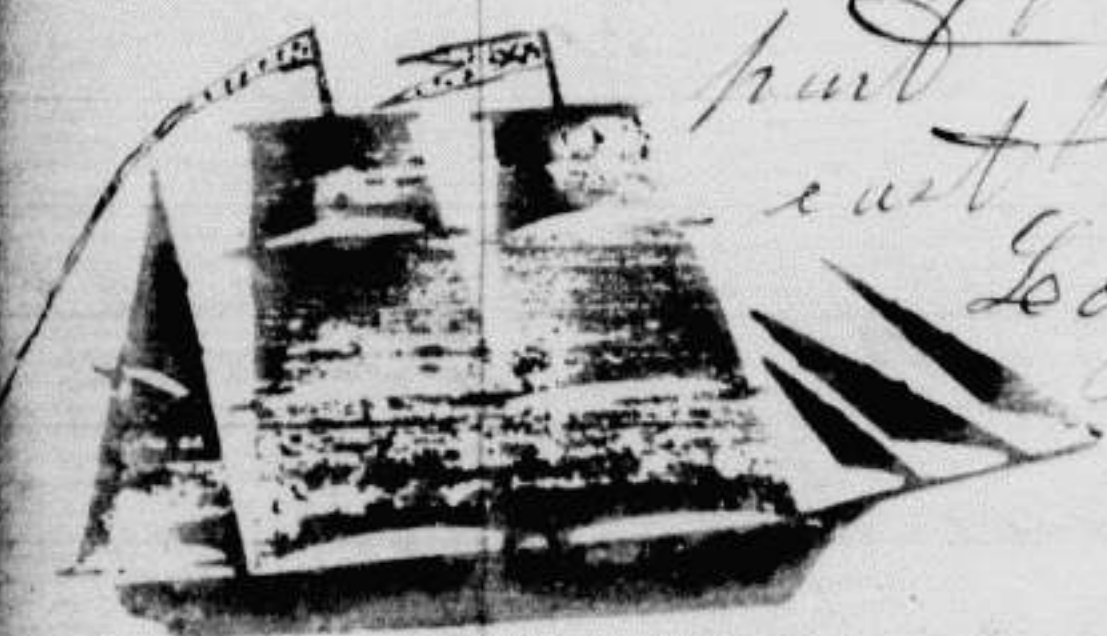
Comment with strong breezes from north east

east by the wind Lat 22.28 N Long 31.45 W

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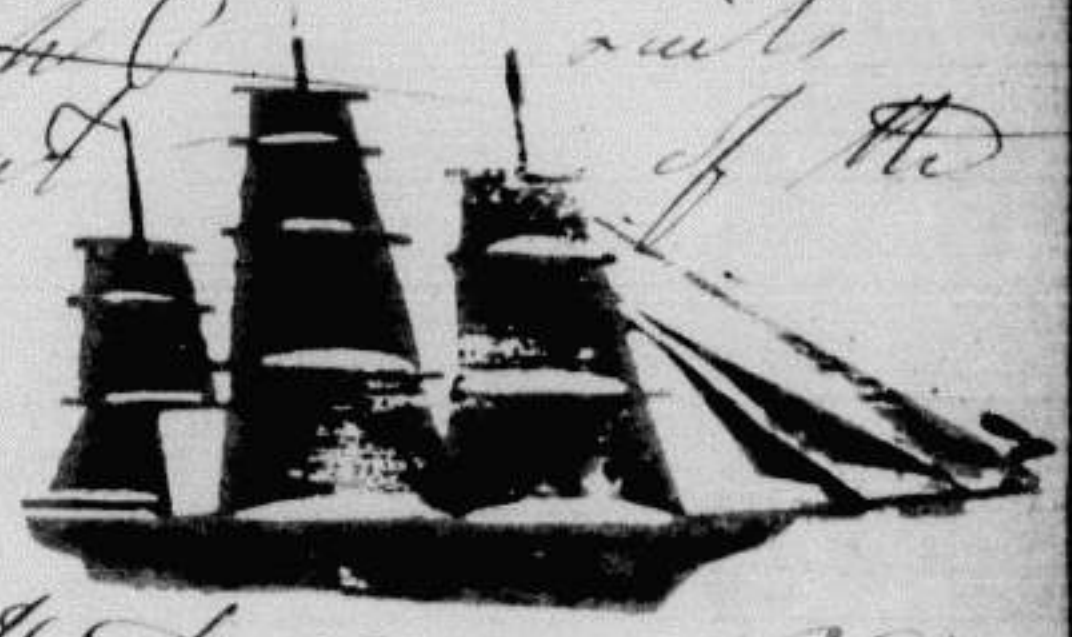
Remarks on board Sunday February the 23rd 1862
