Comment with fresh breezes from north east and raged within the watch employed cutting down late part of the night cleared on strong again took in the fore and mainmast stays and blowing strong had strong breezes steaming north west by north to end Lat 50 00 N Long 44 50 W

Comment with strong breezes from north east and raged within the watch employed in ordinary ship duties had strong breezes then the night at daylight got off with out full mast took in strong breezes to end Lat 50 20 N Long 46 35 W
