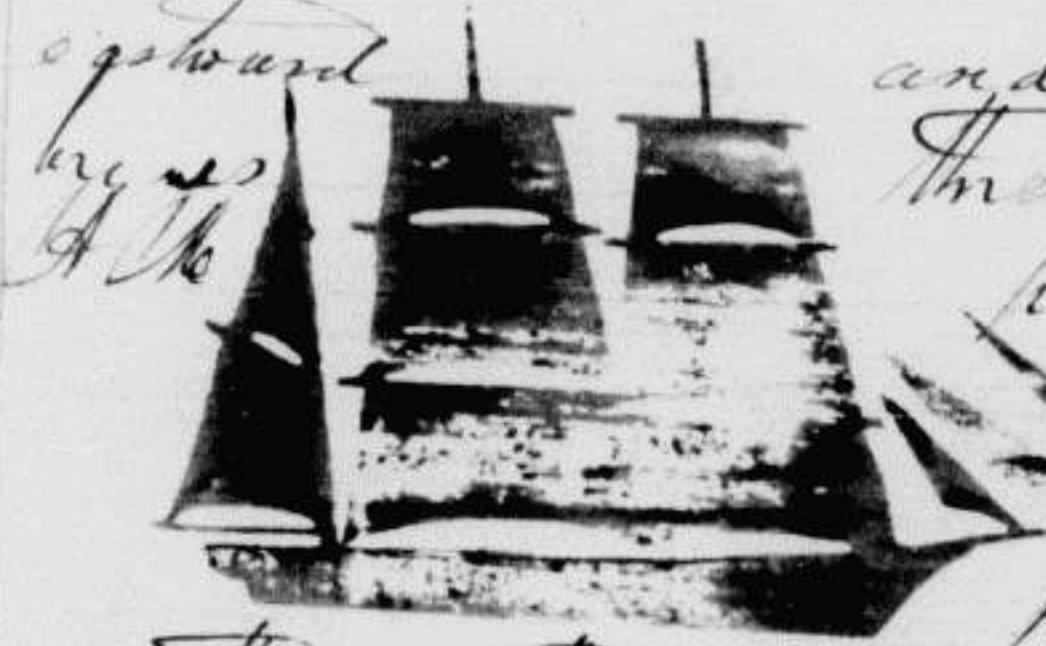
Brig Kate Cary being at Barbados

 of the forenoon at day break at one
 sea took two passengers Captain Allen and the
 doctor late of Bark Lady Suffolk, by light
 breeze then the night at day light at 10
 fore noon late part good weather steering
 north by east by the wind to end
 Lat 13° 49' N Long 59° 50' W

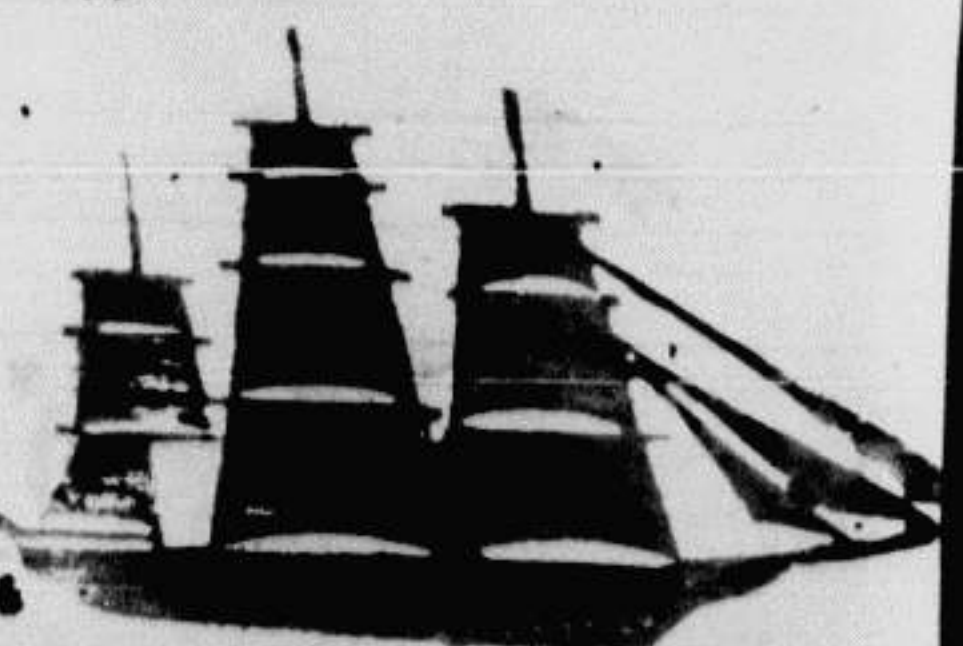
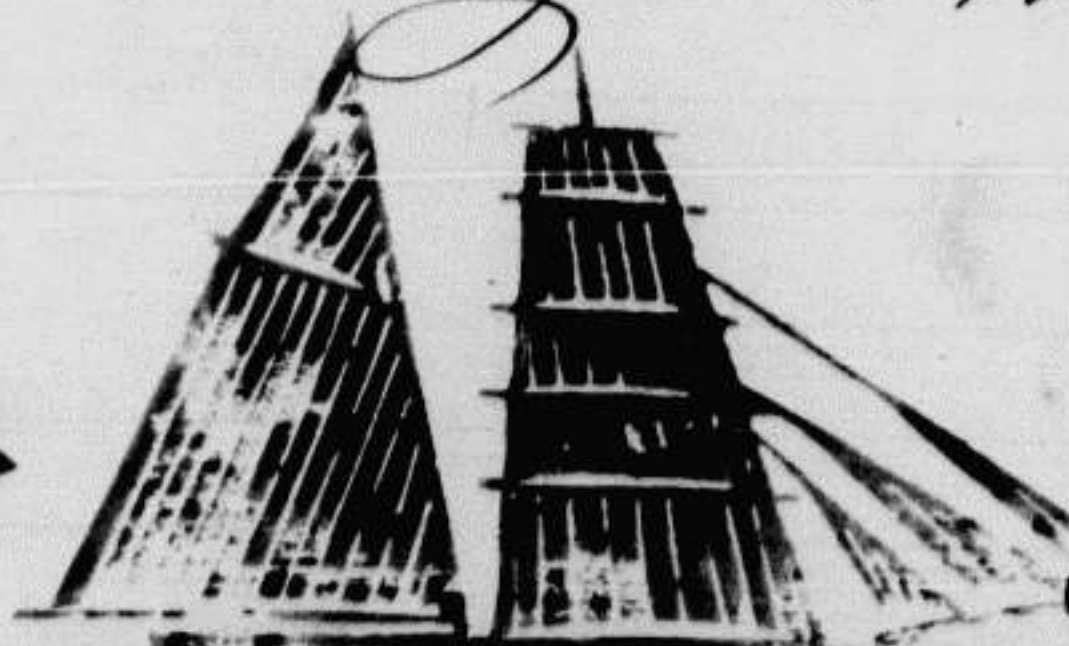
Remarks on board Thursday March the 27th 1862

Commenced with light breeze from the
 eastward and good weather had fine
 breeze then the night at eight
 light breeze from the northward
 Any wind it down and
 sent up and one little
 heat fine breeze steering
 north north east by the wind to end
 Lat 15° 24' Long 60° 00'



Remarks on board Friday March the 28th 1862

Commenced with fine breeze from the
 eastward and good weather the watch
 in ordinary ship duty had light
 breeze then the night at ten o'clock
 at day light at 10 fore noon
 light breeze from the north
 to end Lat 17° 03' N Long 59° 41' W

Commenced with light breeze from the
 eastward and good weather the night
 at day light at 10 fore noon
 light breeze from the north
 to end Lat 18° 07' N Long 60° 44' W

Remarks on board Sunday March the 30th 1862

Commenced with light breeze from the
 eastward and good weather had moderate
 breeze then the night at eight
 light breeze from the north
 to end Lat 18° 53' N Long 61° 46' W

Remarks on board Monday March the 31st 1862

Commenced with light breeze from the eastward and
 good weather had light breeze then the night
 at day light at 10 fore noon
 light breeze from the north
 to end Lat 20° 00' N Long 62° 40' W



Remarks on board Tuesday April the 1st 1862

Commenced with light breeze from the northward
 and fair weather the watch employed repairing the
 mainmast had light breeze then the
 night at eight
 light breeze from the north
 to end Lat 20° 41' N Long 63° 00' W
