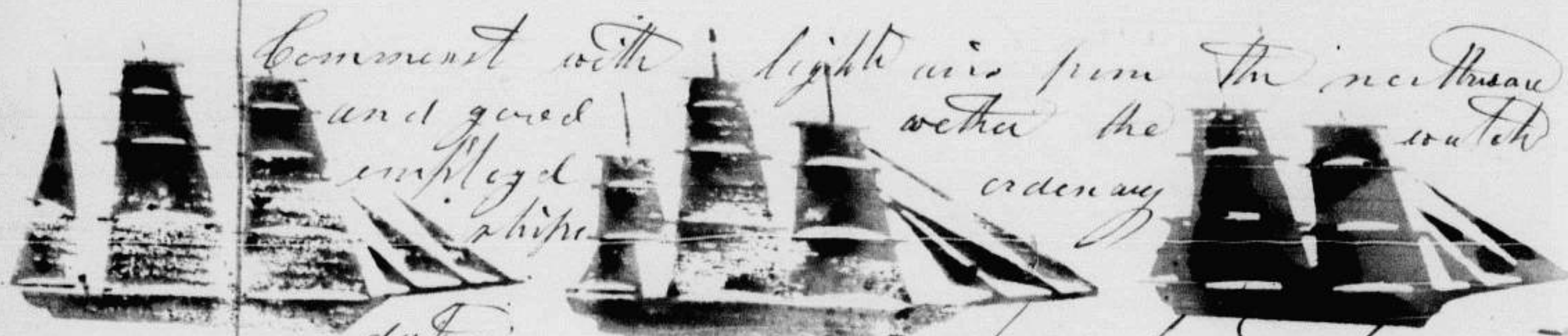
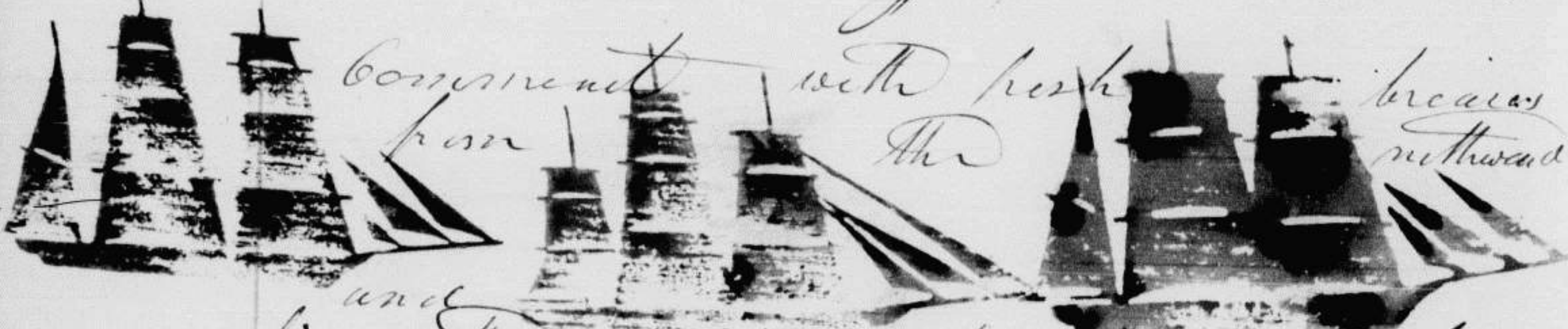

Commenced with light air from the northward

Longitude 64° 36' W

Remarks on board Thursday April the 3rd 1862

Commenced with fresh breeze from the northward
and fair with the four o'clock
P.M. Tack in the fore royal hoisted on
springs and three sails at night. Sailed at
P.M. in the light sails. Made a strong
at four o'clock. At the same time spoke at
from Galapagos head to Santa Rosa So ends
steering north west by the wind latitude
24° 07' N longitude 66° 00' W

Remarks on board Friday April the 4th 1862

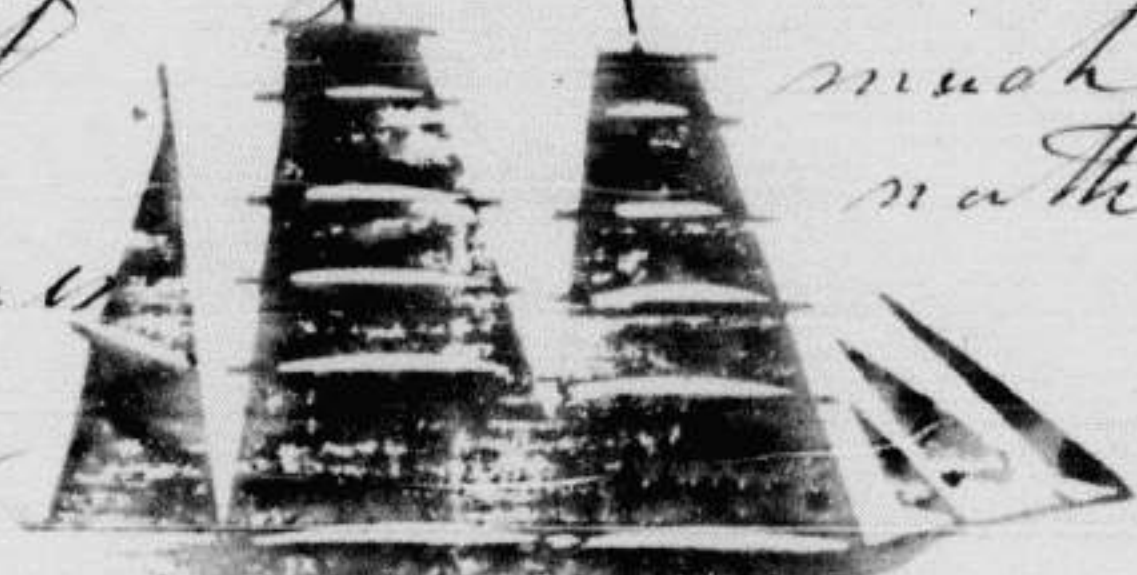
Commenced with strong breeze from north

Remarks on board Saturday April the 5th 1862

Commenced with fresh breeze from the
northward and eastward and a heavy sea
running at three o'clock set the equal
and the mast stay sail. In the afternoon
breeze and fair had light breeze then
the night rather part much
the same steering north
west by north So ends
latitude 23° 50' N
longitude 69° 05' W

Remarks on board Sunday April the 6th 1862

Commenced with light breeze from north
north east and fair with a calm
then the night saw a sail to the north
light part calm So ends latitude 24° 00'
longitude 69° 19' W

Remarks on board Monday April the 7th 1862

Commenced with fine other than calm
got to anchor. At the night
breeze from north got a light
north east by the heading
had light breeze. Then the
night at eight o'clock. At the heard a fresh
from east north east steard north north
west saw three sails. Late part fresh breeze
So ends latitude 24° 25' N
longitude 69° 43' W
