me at this time quiet went to Club Room at 1/4 before 8 o'clock and
home with Mr. Barry at 10 1/2 o'clock at this time rainy with high winds
Tuesday April 6th 1857

Clear this morning, clear, during the day, quite cool, settled with Mr
& E. Hanes, C. M. returned age to day, took a due bill for 29c. doing nothing
special to day received a letter from L. J. Eaton from Pittsburg I
shall answer soon at 6 P.M. not a cloud to be seen quite cool - Aunt
Eliza is here to night - staid at home till 10 minutes to 9 o'clock
then went up street bought the Journal and returned at 10 min
before 10 read the paper and set up for Frank till 15 min past
11 o'clock and then thought it best to go to bed I do not
mean to allow him to go out often to stay talking such
hours for I think it is one of the worst habits a child can
contract in this world for you do not know when they
may go "Wednesday April 7th

A splendid morning clear cool white frost last night and a
beautiful day forenoon. Ships "Montreal" "Young Phoenix" "Mary Miller" and
"Alti" have arrived (the wind is south east) today at this hour 1 o'clock
P.M. also the ship "Lion Heart" arrived today - it is splendid to night
wind south westerly the R. Beebe went to New York last night I went
into the Fair not crowded at all but very warm saw about the
usual amount of dress and beauty saw him & C. Rook with her brother
and his wife we smiled at each other but did not speak with each other

I do what I think is the wisest thing but if I err it is because
I am ignorant of human nature in its varied forms at 10 1/2 a beautiful night - glorious night - still, not a cloud a full moon
