Thursday 30th 41
Clear this morning and a West wind. Wrote letter to Lizzy Boston
to day paid my subscription to Mr Thomas Simsbury
this is the last of my subscription it was paid to Rev Mr
Miss my subscription ends here went to Haver's in the
evening. Then till 10 o'clock came home and went to bed —

 Clear this morning and perfectly ship Levi Starbuck and yesterday
 and John Gelpin the Opera Adams to day clouds at 700 P.M.
 Dr Clothing / Room and S.E. went to Plains
 1835 in the evening. Retire at
 2 Dec 7 To 4 mount. Hunt 10 o'clock \$140.00

Saturday May 2d 1837

Monday 3^d
Went to East Piquette and almost rain - went to Mrs. Cooks
thru the 10th clock and returned home

Monday 2nd
Leaving mid 11th East, next to Boston in the 10¹⁵ o'clock train
looked at several lots of fish finally bought of Fisher and Chappin
Next to Mr. Eaton. Had all night had a very pleasant
time they were all very glad to see me

Tuesday 5th 1837 Mary 15
 woke up about 6 o'clock in Lizzie's Room in Boston cloudy
 and raining went all round Boston and directly took the car
 for home at 2 1/2 o'clock moved at 5 o'clock

Dear beautiful morning and it felt and it is like Spring in the
evening went to hear the Germania Band past into Hall Room
and returned home at 10:30 clock and retired

Clear and fine wind & West in the evening, next to Eglham.
Kensington came home at 10 o'clock.

Friday 8th
 Left for morning home was taken out of the Gladiolus
 to day in the evening went up to Mrs. Shaw's with R.
 Alice came home at 6 o'clock. Mrs. Rice came home
 with us in R. on Saturday 9th

to Hous in the evening met Beatty & H. & I Hitch.
Had a supper. Came home at 11 o'clock.

The morning rather cool went to church. The morning here
 was this week I went to see in the evening.
 returned at 10 3/4 o'clock

Dear a little more mild dear and mostly on the way
next to Haver. Better now, out to H. in Eastwood. Return
home I did and returned at 11 o'clock.

Windsor, Wednesday 14
Mild and pleasant day in the evening. Clouds went to Parker House
Llane & Burt and self walked up Purchase St together then
came home. Retired 10 1/2 o'clock

Cloudy in the evening went up street and came home at 9
 Rod Boston Journal and went to bed 10 1/2 clock

During the last evening during the day an evening visit
to Haines on the rising foot hills of Haines & Hatcher talked
with Mr. C. C. C. came home from the country and had a good

Sunday 17
During the morning went to Forest Road for mail &
good morning - very cold to day we have had but very little
