Saturday June 6th 1837

A clear morning mild or cool for the season but fine not a cloud to be seen nature wears at this time the most splendid livery it is very pleasant to walk among the trees and green fields and breathe the pure air and inhale the thousand delicate perfumes of nature as they are wrought in her laboratory in the evening went to Mr. B's met R.B. home at 11.

Sunday 7th

Cloudy mild & W. sprinkles a little the birds song beautifully nature is clothed in her greenest livery rainy during the day went to church the sun appeared. Continued cloudy till 10 P.M. went to Mrs. C's in the evening - home at 10 1/2 clock.

Monday 8th

A beautiful morning not a cloud to be seen very beautiful after the rain of yesterday in the evening went to Mrs. H's room till 10 1/2 clock clear night.

Tuesday 9th

cloudy partly mild or cool continues cloudy during the day in the evening went to Beale's yard and to Hanes home at 11 o'clock.

Wednesday 10th

Frank did not sleep any at all last night in consequence of a very severe toothache at 12 o'clock went up to Mrs. Tobey's with him and had it taken out which he did in just one second cloudy somewhat and mild & East in the evening went to Hanes & Beale's home at 10 o'clock.

Thursday 11th

Cloudy mild & East - rainy during the day cloudy in the evening at Hanes - home 10 1/2.

Friday 12th

Clear mild or cool pleasant in the evening went to Mrs. Whitney's stayed at Hanes when I went home home at 10 o'clock. Home at 12 o'clock to day - Saturday 13th

Clear mild & West Clear and beautiful

in the evening went into Hanes home at 10 o'clock in road to Hanes purchased Washington's life of Washington and Tupper's "Practical philosophy" came home at 10 o'clock.

Sunday 14th

Clear mild partly clear and beautiful went to church listened to a very good discourse from Mr. Biss on "Hypocritism in the church" - met at Potomski's received 8 letters returned at 8 o'clock returned at 11 o'clock and was in company till 11 o'clock.

Monday 15th

clear fine day bright in the evening collected on Mrs. H. North's stopped till 10 o'clock - at 11 o'clock.

Tuesday 16th 1837 June 1837

Cloudy and rainy night and fine to Mrs. H. & Perry in the evening went to Hanes.

Wednesday 17th

Went to Boston to the great celebration returned in the evening at 10 o'clock and retired.

Thursday 18th

Cloudy and rainy. Sold 25 West Row to J. H. Bartlett in the evening met J. J. Russell & C. home at 10 o'clock.

Friday 19th

Cloudy and rainy night to Hanes in the evening.

Saturday 20th

clear & rainy in the evening went to Hanes home at 11 o'clock. Knight, Butler, Tucker and self were there.

Sunday 21st

cloudy & cleared away at 10 o'clock some news to David's head a very good sermon from Mr. Bliss on "faith" the fashion of this world &c.

Monday 22nd

Cloudy and rainy in the evening & clear went to Mrs. H. home at 11 o'clock.

Tuesday 23rd

Clear mild & Northwesterly nothing has taken place out of the usual course in the evening went to Beale's & Hanes home at 11 o'clock.

Wednesday 24th

Clear mild & Northwesterly to write all the passing events would require a great deal of time. Sometimes there are events we like to record and to remember but in the bosom of most persons there is monotony and we must expect to be humble workers in this world it must be sweet and honorable to toil peacefully in any calling as well as to die for one's country - at home at 10 o'clock spent the evening at Beale's counting room and stopped at Hanes when we came home.

Thursday 25th

Clear in the morning, warm in the afternoon rain about 4 o'clock went to ride about 6 o'clock thought it had done raining but got up as far as Mr. Popham's it began to look quite black and it rained straight down and we got wet as anybody would wish Frank and Henry were with me we had a thunder storm that continued till 8 o'clock home at 10 o'clock on Mrs. H's.

Friday 26th

Clear midday in the evening went to Mrs. C's home with R. Beale returned at 9 o'clock took a sail on the Ocean at Fiddler's and went into Hanes home at 10 o'clock.
