I do not think there is much pleasure in leaving home. I think there is so much time you have nothing to do and to wait for this and that object that it is about equal to state prison life. I have resolved I will never travel except with a place of visiting and let nothing interfere with that and when I get through come home. My times of travelling have been very unpleasant often in waiting or some annoying thing, and I had rather read of the places and feed my imagination than to make such sacrifices in going to see them. It will do if you have very pleasant company. I have no doubt. Let it be a certain place or point where you are going. Then you start and know just how you can travel. After all I am much more happy when I am at home than almost anywhere else on Earth. In the evening was at Mrs. Lindsay's. Sam. May, Elmstead, of Hartford Conn. Arrived Monday 22^d 1859. Clear fair morning. The Brigade Band from Boston played finely in front of the Parker House. Walked up with Mr. Beecher at home at 10 o'clock. Tuesday 23^d 1859 August. Pleasant this morning the Washington Greys arrived with the U.S. Army Band from Brooklyn (Ct) music excellent. "FIRE" Wednesday 24th August 1859. Oo Dang was the fire that destroyed such a large amount of property. But I trust it will yet be well that we were thus afflicted. I have faith in the Supreme ruler of the universe, and I trust the lesson it has taught is especially this, that human sympathy is a very small compensation for the loss of property; also, we now should always be insured where there is the least risk. I would enforce that lesson; and I have many lessons that I would remember. I omit many days here and will commence. 1859 Wednesday 28th of September. This morning quite pleasant and to day has been mild in the evening a smart shower. See the 1st Part of this Book.
