

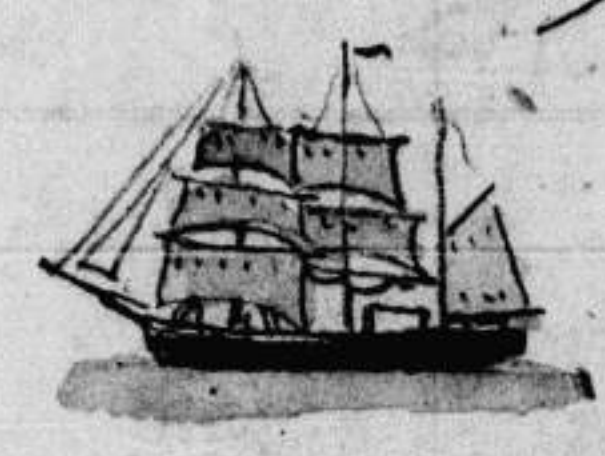
Ship Kensington outward bound

Saturday Oct 24, 1857
Remarks on Board commenced with strong
breeze from the E and heavy flaws ship by
the Wind to the S E Middle part Wind from
the S E at 10,30 clock took ship to the S E
latter part much the same so ends this day
all well
Satt by obs 36 10 N
Long by Chronometer 61 00 W

Sunday Oct 25, 1857
Remarks on Board commenced with mod-
erate Winds and Rainy Wind from the S E ship
by the Wind to the S E Middle and latter part
light baffling Winds from varied parts of the
compass and light squalls of rain so ends this
day all well
Satt by obs 36 53 N
Long by Chronometer 61 03 W

Monday Oct 26, 1857
Remarks on Board commenced with fine
Breezes from the S E ship by the Wind to the
E S E spoke the bark Crusoe bound to New York
at 5 AM took in the top gallant sails and
fly jib Middle part Tally right the topsails
latter part strong gales from the S E hading to the
E under last reef spriz top sail and storm sails
so ends this day all well
Satt by obs 37, 25 N

Tuesday Oct 27, 1857
Remarks on Board commenced with a gale
from the S E hading to the E Middle and
latter part more moderate so the topsails Tally
Right and lodes through the latter part strong breezes
commenced again with employed in varied jobs
so ends this day Dark and overcast
Satt by obs 37, 13 N
Long by Chronometer 58, 58 W

Wednesday Oct 28, 1857
Remarks on Board commenced with strong
Breezes and dark Weather and heavy Rain squalls
much thunder and lightning Wind from the S E
lode E S E took in the fore and mizen top sails &
lodes soon set them again all through the Middle
and latter part strong breezes & heavy squalls much
lightning with a heavy swell heaving in from the S E
Wind from the S saw one ship steering to E S E so
ends this day
Satt by obs 37, 26 N
Long by Chronometer 56 02 W

Thursday Oct 29, 1857
Remarks on Board commenced with strong
Breezes heavy swell & squally Wind from the
S E lode E S E ship under Tally reef top sails jib
lodes Middle part more moderate latter part fine
Breeze made all sail all hands employed in
dashing up spars & galing up our cuttin points
and other varied jobs so ends this day
Satt by obs 38, 19 N

Friday Oct 30, 1857
Remarks on Board commenced with fine breeze
from the S lode E S E light squalls of rain ship
under full sail Middle part the same latter part
strong breeze and light squalls of rain took in
the fore & mizen top gallant sail so ends this
day
No obs

Saturday Oct 31, 1857
Remarks on Board commenced with strong breeze
from the S Dark Weather light squalls of rain with
employed in setting up rigging breeze freshen's Tally
Right the top sails close S E S Middle part more moderate
latter part much rain Wind from the S E lode S E
so ends this day
Satt by obs 36 32 N
Long by Chronometer 46-38 W
