light sails & double reefed the top sails latter part

repairing the main top gallant sail & other rigging
Sails set ends this day Satt by abs 26 11 S
Long by Chronometer 21 28 W

Friday Dec 11 1854
Remarks on Board commenced with strong
breeze from the SE ship by the wind to the E
middle & latter part calm latter part light
breeze from the SW which employed in getting out
water & in getting in other rigging sails to ends this
day Satt by abs 28 42 S
Long by Chronometer 30 26 W

Saturday Dec 12 1854
Remarks on Board commenced with light air
& calm middle & latter part light air from the
SE W. Course SE by S set the studding sails & sent the
main top sail down to repair finished it & bent it
a gain to ends this day Satt by abs 26 02 S
Long by Chronometer 19 32 W

Sunday Dec 13 1854
Remarks on Board commenced with light air
from the SE W. Course SE by S middle & latter part
same as fore fin back light squall of rain so ends
this day Satt by abs 27 12 S
Long by Chronometer 18 21 W

Monday Dec 14 1854
Remarks on Board commenced with light air & calm
which varied much & often course SE middle part squa
latter part fine weather which employed in brailing out
stowing over the between decks so ends this day
Satt by abs 27 03 S

Remarks on Board commenced with light breeze
from the SE by the wind to the Eastward middle
part backed ship to the latter part wind from the
SE back ship to the E which employed in various jobs
fine weather so ends this day Satt by abs 28 20 S
Long by Chronometer 14 02 W

Wednesday Dec 16 1854
Remarks on Board commenced with strong
breeze from the SE ship by the wind to the E
middle & latter part light and over calmer which employ
ed in ship's duty so ends this day Satt by abs 32 30 S
Long by Chronometer 16 48 W

Thursday Dec 17 1854
Remarks on Board commenced with light air
& calm middle & latter part fine breeze from the
SE Course SE which employed in ship's duty
ends this day Satt by abs 30 41 S
Long by Chronometer 18 21 W

Friday Dec 18 1854
Remarks on Board commenced with strong
breeze from the SE ship by the wind to the
SE middle part strong breeze from SE back in
the light sails & double reefed the top sails backing to
the latter part fine weather which employed in
this day bent a new storme surzen so ends this day
Satt by abs 30 04 S
Long by Chronometer 14 32 W

Saturday Dec 19 1854
Remarks on Board commenced with moderate
breeze from the SE by the wind to the SE middle
part light breeze from the SE Course SE & latter part
fine breeze from the SE employed in sheathing the
deck saw fin back so ends this day
Satt by abs 32 10 S
Long by Chronometer 14 19 W
