Remarks on Board commenced with a gale from the NW much fog & rain lying too under the sail heading to the NE & middle part more moderate. Latter part more ship to the Westward several ships in sight saw for back so ends this day. Lat by alt 48 41

Monday Jan 18 1858

Remarks on Board commenced with strong breeze from the NW ship in both tacks saw one ship & a latter one cutting middle part moderate breeze latter part strong breeze saw several ships at Whaler board got to the landward boat one boat capsize took the Whaler to the ship & got ridy for cutting so ends this day. Lat by alt 48 41

Tuesday Jan 19 1858

Remarks on Board commenced with strong breeze & fine weather employed in cutting in fine weather & saw some sail middle & latter part much the same commenced by lying so ends this day. Lat by alt 48 41

Wednesday Jan 20 1858

Remarks on Board commenced with strong breeze from the NW ship under short sail heading middle part strong breeze & raining latter part moderate weather saw for back Whaler board got some several in sight saw for back so ends this day. Lat by alt 48 27 S

Long by Chronometer 10 07 E

Thursday Jan 21 1858

Remarks on Board commenced with moderate weather wind from the NW ship under both tacks employed in trying out middle part wind & weather the same latter part strong breeze & raining saw several Whales going to the Westward quick did not lose so ends this day. Lat by alt 48 25 S

Friday Jan 22 1858

Remarks on Board commenced with strong breeze & fog & some rain wind from the NW employed in trying out middle part strong breeze thick fog & middle part strong breeze & clear weather & ends this day. Lat by alt 48 38 S

Long by Chronometer 10 46 E

Saturday Jan 23 1858

Remarks on Board commenced with strong breeze & clear weather wind from the NW middle part strong breeze & clear weather saw several ships in sight saw one Whaler board got some so ends this day. Lat by alt 48 38 S

Sunday Jan 24 1858

Remarks on Board commenced with light breeze & fog middle part steering to the Westward from the North much fog latter part the same ship by the West to the NE about 10 o'clock ship aboat so ends this day. Lat by alt 48 38 S

Monday Jan 25 1858

Remarks on Board commenced with moderate breeze from the NW & middle part moderate & latter part strong breeze & clear weather several ships in sight so ends this day. Lat by alt 48 31 S

Long by Chronometer 10 31 E

Tuesday Jan 26 1858

Remarks on Board commenced with strong breeze from the North & clear weather middle part wind from the NW latter part the wind very shift & blowing a gale & some rain took in the fore & main top sail. Whaler ship to the NE several ships in sight so ends this day. Lat by alt 48 04 S

Wednesday Jan 27 1858

Remarks on Board commenced with a moderate gale from the NW lying too under easy sail middle & latter part strong breeze & fine weather steering different courses making 10 miles over so ends this day. Lat by alt 48 04 S
