Friday Jan 24 1858
Remarks on Board commenced with moderate
breeze & much fog Wind from the N. S. S. & Middle part
Middle part Wind & Weather the same nothing seen so
from the N. S. S. a heavy fog & much rain last
reap the main top sail took in the fore & main
last to fresh squalls & a heavy sea brought the ship
too by the Wind under last reef main top sail &
Storm sails split the main top sail by lifting it up
to good thing it to ends this Day
Sailed by obs

Saturday Jan 25 1858
Remarks on Board commenced with a gale from
the N. S. S. the gale began to moderate Middle part left
the ship of N. S. S. set the top sails & table reef
Latter part strong breeze from the N. S. S. Weather
Wind & sea main top sail & fore stay sail to ends
this Day
Sailed by obs 45 or 1

Sunday Jan 26 1858
Remarks on Board commenced with strong
breeze & rainy Wind from the N. S. S. & Middle
part heavy squalls & much rain took in the fore &
main top sail latter part set them a gain likewise
mainsail & Gib soon had to take them in again at
this time blowing a fresh gale from the N. S. S. Wind
hauled to the West blowing fresh & a heavy cross sea
brought the ship too by under last reef main top sail
& storm sails to ends this Day No obs

Monday Feb 1 1858
Remarks on Board commenced with a fresh gale from
the N. S. S. lying to Middle & latter part the gale more
left the ship of before it sent in the fore & main
in other words so ends this Day Sailed by obs 18 00
Sailed by Chronometer 23 00 E

Tuesday Feb 2 1858

Remarks on Board commenced with a moderate
gale from the N. S. S. & Middle part moderate
breeze latter part fine breeze & light squalls of rain. Made all
sail due finders to ends this Day Sailed by obs 44 27
Sailed by Chronometer 54 00 E

Wednesday Feb 3 1858
Remarks on Board commenced with strong breeze
& light squalls of hail Wind from the N. S. S. Middle &
latter part Wind and Weather the same nothing seen so
ends this Day
Sailed by obs 44 20
Sailed by Chronometer 51 00 E

Thursday Feb 4 1858
Remarks on Board commenced with strong
breeze from the N. S. S. & light squalls of rain latter
part Middle & latter part strong breeze & clear weather
Wind from the N. S. S. Captain's deck with the Runabout
to ends this Day
Sailed by obs 44 36
Sailed by Chronometer 58 00 E

Friday Feb 5 1858
Remarks on Board commenced with strong breeze
& thick Rainy weather took in the light sails
& table reef the top sails & took in the main sail
Middle part the same latter part moderate breeze & much
fog made all sail to ends this Day Sailed by obs 44 36
Sailed by Chronometer 58 00 E

Saturday Feb 6 1858
Remarks on Board commenced with strong breeze
& much fog Wind from the N. S. S. & Middle
& latter part much the same so ends this Day
Sailed by obs 44 20
Sailed by Chronometer 64 30 E

Sunday Feb 7 1858
Remarks on Board commenced with strong breeze &
heavy weather Wind from the N. S. S. & Middle part
Clear weather latter part thick fog so ends this Day
Sailed by obs 44 00
Sailed by Chronometer 64 30 E
