Remarks on Board commenced with light

one hatch on shore second officer still of duty and confined
so ends this day

Saturday May 29th 58
Remarks on Board commenced with fine weather
midell & latter part strong S.W. wind & much rain
dropt the starboard anchor one hatch on shore second
officer still confined so ends this day

Sunday May 30th 58
Remarks on Board commenced with strong S.W.
wind & rainy midell part the same latter part strong
breeze & heavy weather second mate still confined hatch
on shore so ends this day

Monday May 31st 58
Remarks on Board commenced with strong S.E. trades
& clear weather midell part squalls of rain latter part
much the same the blacksmith & Charles pence directed
from the ship second mate still confined on board hatch
on shore so ends this day

Remarks on Board commenced with strong S.E.
trades midell & latter part the same hatch on shore
second officer still confined so ends this day
