Remarks on Board commenced with strong breeze from the S.E. & S.W. Middle & latter part strong breeze from the N.E. employed in laying out black fish traps in the light sails so ends this day
Satt by abs 31, 48 S
Sang by Chronometer 17638 W

Sunday Jan 3 1858

Remarks on Board commenced with strong breeze & heavy squalls latter part the top sails hauled the main sail & jib. Middle part took in the fore top sail latter part fine weather sea calm made all sail so ends this day Satt by abs 31 25 S
Sang by Chronometer 177 56 W, by lunar 177, 20 48

Monday Jan 4 1858

Remarks on Board commenced with strong breeze S.W. Middle & latter part strong breeze & clear weather employed in taking down & breaking out bread and stowing other cargo for Wotten Taw. Sperm Whales going quick to W. & N.W. did not fare so ends this day Satt by abs 30, 41 S
Sang by Chronometer 178 25 W, by lunar 178 56 E

Tuesday Jan 5 1858

Remarks on Board commenced with strong breeze from the S.W. & fine weather Middle & latter part the same all hands employed in breaking out & setting up Shooks for Wotten & other cargo so ends this day
Satt by abs 30 43 S
Sang by Chronometer 178 25 E

Wednesday Jan 6 1858

Remarks on Board commenced with moderate weather Middle part light rain squalls latter fine weather employed in setting up pipes Shooks Wotten from the W. so ends this day
Satt by abs 30 56 S
Sang by Chronometer 177 30 E by lunar 178 34 W E

Monday Jan 23 1858

Remarks on Board commenced with fine weather lying at anchor in the harbor. Middle & latter part fine weather and much on shore so ends this day

Tuesday Jan 24 1858

Remarks on Board commenced with fine weather all this day employed in Wattering Ship & breaking out oil for freighting home so ends this day

Wednesday Jan 25 1858

Remarks on Board all this day employed in Discharging oil & getting Water on board so ends this day

Thursday Jan 26 1858

Remarks on Board this day employed in Wattering Ship so ends this day

Friday Jan 27 1858

Remarks on Board commenced with fine weather employed in Wattering Ship. Much on shore so ends this day

Saturday Jan 28 1858

Remarks on Board commenced with fine weather Wattering Ship so ends this day

Sunday Jan 29 1858

Remarks on Board all this day Wattering & painting Ship Much on shore so ends this day

Monday Jan 30 1858

Remarks on Board commenced with fine weather Much on shore so ends this day

Tuesday Jan 31 1858

Remarks on Board all this day employed in Wattering & painting Ship for autumn. Permitted the second time from the Ship so ends this day
