Remarks on Board commenced With a fine
breeze from the W backing to SE Weather calm
& cloudy middle part the same latter part strong breeze
& heavy rain Wind from the W so ends this Day
No abs

Thursday Mar 31 1859
Remarks on Board commenced With strong breeze
& thick heavy rain Wind from the W middle part much
rain & heavy squalls near some of our sails latter part
a new false topsail & spack the ship may sail so
ends this Day
