Remarks on Board commenced with light breeze from E & fine weather, lar. & M. Middle & latter part light breeze, & fine weather. Much employed in various jobs so ends this day

Friday Apr 22 1859

Remarks on Board commenced with light breeze from the SE lar. & M. Middle & latter part light air employed in repairing boats & painting them so ends this day

Sat by ab 13 15 N

Sang by Chronometer 188 30 E

Saturday Apr 23 1859

Remarks on Board commenced with light air from the SE lar. & M. Middle part fresh breeze from the SE & misty rain took in the light sails first of the latter part. Wind from E & moderate made all sail. Wind soon shifted to the NE & blowing fresh & raining took in the light sails & double reefed the top sails so ends this day

Sunday Apr 24 1859

Remarks on Board commenced with fresh breeze from the NE & misty rain lar. & M. Middle part the lar. & M. Middle & latter part. Dark weather & misty rain fine breeze made all sail so ends this day

Monday Apr 25 1859

Remarks on Board commenced with a fine breeze & dark rainy weather. Wind from the E lar. & M. Middle part. Wind from the SE latter part from for M. employed in mending shoes but a good sail so ends this day

Monday May 14 1859

Remarks on Board commenced with light air from the SW & much fog Middle & latter part the same plenty of fog backed a wind the ship firing a redder to the Mast boat & the latter being unhooked the train gave way & stove her. The Carpenter fell over board no person named so ends this day so ab

Wednesday March 18 1859

Remarks on Board commenced with much fog Wind from the SE Middle & latter part the same so ends this day so ab

Thursday May 19 1859

Remarks on Board commenced with light breeze & fog Wind soon hauled to the SE & cleared of the fog lar. in sight Dist 30 to 40 miles Middle & latter part fine weather saw Whales lar. & M. all day got more land in sight spoke Ship California & went out 5.30 so ends this day

Remarks on Board commenced with light breeze & fine weather Middle & latter part strong breeze

Saw several Whales lar. several times struck none so ends this day Sat by ab 40 44 N

Remarks on Board commenced with strong breeze Middle & latter part calm weather & thick fog so ends this day so ab

Sunday May 22 1859

Remarks on Board commenced with light air & calm & hazy weather. Fire back's Middle & latter part light air from the SE. Fire back's so ends this day
