Middle & latter part the same ship 2 boats sent out
recruits on board Discharged the 4 White ship 3
mate so ends this day

Saturday Nov 5 1859

Remarks on Board commenced With fine
Weather Middle & latter part the same latter part
preparing to leave port 2 boats took out anchor
and put to sea this part Discharged 12 men &
ship 10 all on board & ship out ward bound
so ends this day

Sunday Nov 6 1859

Remarks on Board commenced With light
air running down the coast between shore
key & rain all this 24 hours not clear of the
land started the gullies so ends this day

Monday Nov 7 1859

Remarks on Board commenced With light air
& Calms Middle & latter part the same ran up
Dist 18 miles having 2 boats in play in repairing
boats with other varied jobs so ends this day

Tuesday Nov 8 1859

Remarks on Board commenced With light
air & Calms Middle & latter part much the
same employed in mending boat and other
various jobs so ends this day

from the N Middle & latter part light air
from the N & employed in painting boats so
ends this day

Breeze from the SW heading to the S Ocean
Weather Middle part the same Wind strong
Middle latter part strong breeze saw 11 whales

on board a fair so ends this day

Wednesday Dec 14 1859

Remarks on Board commenced With light
air & drizzly rain Middle & latter part Calms
rain & fog squalls last of the latter part Wind
from the NW W large W by S so ends this day

Thursday Dec 15 1859

Remarks on Board commenced With strong
Breeze from the NW W large W by S took in the
light sails Jabblocraft the top sails down rain
Middle part light air & rainy latter part strong gale
from the NW W took in the fore & main top
sail lost part the main so ends this day

Went across fore stay sail

Friday Dec 16 1859

Remarks on Board commenced With a gale from
the W by N Middle part more moderate
latter part made all sail heading to the NW W
so ends this day
