 Remarks on Board Commenced with fine breeze from the N.W. working to the Westward middle & latter part light breeze & fine weather saw 2 ships the abraham harper so ends this day

 Remarks on Board Commenced with fine weather & a light breeze from the S.E. middle part the same latter part wind from S.W. close S.W. saw 2 ships the bark gipsy & the bark pineas so ends this day No obs

 Remarks on Board Commenced with fine breeze & fine weather wind from the S.W. close S.W. middle part strong breeze steering the same latter part strong breeze & much rain wind hauled to the N.W. so ends this day No obs

 Remarks on Board Commenced with thick rainy weather at 10th started sail for the right mate with 1st had eyes middle & latter part fine weather saw fin backs and sail in sight so ends this day

 Remarks on Board Commenced with light breeze & fine weather from S.W. engaged in hunting out ship cast & the Island of Auckland in light distant 40 miles also saw 2 latter part calms
