Remarks on board commenced with fine breeze
& fine weather working to the S. Middle part
where ship is N.W. latter part fine weather
gained with the last sea gal so ends this day

Remarks on board commenced with fine
weather middle & latter part the same so ends
this day

Thursday June 7th 1860

Remarks on board commenced with a moderate
breeze & rainy wind from the S.W. all the middle
part heavy rain latter part but in the S.W. some
heavy squalls thunder & lightning so ends this
day

Friday June 8th 1860

Remarks on board commenced with strong
Westerly wind employed in clearing a way
& commenced laying latter part blain a gale from
the W. & a heavy sea so ends this day

Saturday June 9th 1860

Remarks on board commenced with a gale from
the W. it was some to quit laying middle
part Wind & Weather the same latter part more
moderate commenced laying a gain so ends
this day

Sunday June 10th 1860

Remarks on board commenced with strong
breeze from the West & ragged employed in
laying middle part moderate weather latter part
fine weather so ends this day

Monday June 11th 1860

Remarks on board commenced with light breeze
from the S.W. still laying middle & latter part fine
Weather finished laying saw five birds some light
squalls again so ends this day
