

Ship Kensington for Sydney June 27

Thursday June 27th 60
Remarks on board commenced with fine breeze from the S.W. land in sight at 10 AM made Sydney light at 1 PM took pilot & the tug boat & came up to the anchor age so ends this day

Friday June 28th 60
Remarks on board commenced with fine weather wind from the South Middle & latter part wind from the S.W. weather dark & heavy lying at anchor in pinch gut (lost by the battery) so ends this day

Saturday June 29th 60
Remarks on board commenced with calm weather middle part the same latter part employed in breaking out oil for sail. Made oil 84, 25 1/2 bbls Spun 49, 12 1/2 bbls so ends this day

Sunday July 1st 60
Remarks on board commenced with fine weather Middle & latter part much the same and which on shore so ends this day

Monday July 2nd 60
Remarks on board commenced with fine weather Middle & latter part the same took on board 100 & 60 barrels of water so ends this day

Tuesday July 3rd 60
Remarks on board commenced with fine weather wind from the W Middle part latter part calm weather employed in landing oil & painting ship so ends

Wednesday July 4th 60
Remarks on board commenced with fine weather Middle & latter part the same made on shore and portique selected from the ship so ends this day

Thursday July 5th 60
Remarks on board commenced with Westley wind Middle part heavy rain latter part sun fog which on shore other employed in painting ship so ends this day

Friday July 6th 60
This day commenced with Westley wind & fine weather employed in setting up shooks & painting ship. Made on shore & made more of the ship canvas selected caught 2 of them so ends this day

Saturday July 7th 60
Remarks on board commenced with Westley wind & weather employed in setting up tarp for water & painting which on shore so ends this day

Sunday July 8th 60
Remarks on board commenced with fine weather Middle & latter part strong breeze from the S.W. & raining which on shore & discharged and boat stolen so ends this day

Monday July 9th 60
Remarks on board commenced with dark rainy weather latter part fine weather employed in getting on board provisions took on board this day 3, 21, 60 lbs bread so ends this day

Tuesday July 10th 60
Remarks on board commenced with fine weather & more men selected from the ship Middle & latter part fine weather employed in getting on board meat received on board 84 bbls so ends this day

Wednesday July 11th 60
Commenced with fine weather & Middle part rain latter part employed in getting on board recruits & wood so ends this day
