Sunday oct 14th 1860

Remarks on board commenced with a strong breeze from the N.W. & rain, employed in trying out Middle & latter part fine breeze from the N.W. saw several boats. Did not strike land on board so ends this day.

Monday oct 15th 1860

Remarks on board commenced with a fine breeze from the N.W. & fine weather still trying out Middle part finished bay line latter part fine weather employed in stowing down saw several Whales board 2 for them got none so ends this day.

Tuesday oct 16th 1860

Remarks on board commenced with fine breeze from the N.W. & fine weather did not finish stowing down Middle & latter part light breeze & fine weather finished stowing down saw Whales board got none employed in setting up shawl & strapping cans so ends this day.

Wednesday oct 17th 1860

Remarks on board commenced with light breeze from the S & fine weather still balanced of duty with the sea near real breeze oct the 10 & still remains Middle & latter part strong breeze saw one Whale did not strike so ends this day.

Thursday oct 18th 1860

Remarks on board commenced with strong breeze from the S Middle part from the N.W. latter part from the N. strong breeze & rain saw Whales board struck & got one to the bar board boat took him to the ship & commenced cutting did not finish so ends this day No abs.

Friday oct 19th 1860

Remarks on board commenced with strong breeze from the N & rain Middle part the same latter part strong breeze employed in bay line so ends this day.
