Monday Oct 22nd 1860

Remarks an board commences with strong breeze from the NW in playing out middle & latter part a moderate gale from the NW in playing out in stowing down nothing seen so ends this day

Tuesday Oct 23rd 1860

Remarks an board commences with a moderate gale from the NW in playing out middle part fine weather saw 8 pack the ship. Watterslett so ends this day

Wednesday Oct 24th 1860

Remarks an board commences with fine breeze from the NW in playing out middle part steering to the NW under short sail latter part saw sight of the land did not get on land on board heard the seckant time boatmen mis one to the NW so ends this day

Remarks an board commences with strong Easterly Wind backing to the NW in playing out middle & latter part Wind from the NW steering to the Westland weather thick & raining so ends this day
