Remarks on board Cambridge
With a light breeze from the
S.W. Course West fine weather
all sail out middle part wind
held more to the S. More ship
steering W. latter part strong breeze
Washed one side of the ship so
raged could do no more so
Wards it spall the stonewall
left hits over 2 other sails
steering to the Eastward so ends
this day

Wednesday Augth 21 1861

Remarks on board Cambridge
With a strong breeze from
the S. dark weather & heavy
fog the light sails course
W. by N. middle part set top gallant
sails even single reef top sails
latter part more moderate made
all sail W. in fog & rain
so ends this day

Thursday Augth 22 1861

Remarks on board Cambridge
With fine breeze & fine weather
Wind from the S. Course W. by N.
middle & latter part calm &
light air from the S.W. the
middle of the latter part fresh
breeze took in the light sails
& single reef top sails
W. in fog & rain so ends this day

Friday Augth 23 1861

Remarks on board Cambridge
With a fresh breeze from the
S.W. & clear weather Course W. by N.
middle part blowing a gale fresh
squalls took in the main sail
Jib & close reefed the top sails
latter part a fresh gale heavy
squalls took in the fore sail fore
& main top sail sent down the
main royal yard Wind hauled to
the S.W. & began to moderate
More ship & set the top sails close
reeft one ship in sight steering to
the Westward so ends this day

Saturday Augth 24 1861

Remarks on board Cambridge
With a fine breeze & a rugged sea
Wind from the S.W. set the main
sail & Jib & single reef top sails
middle part made all sail fine breeze
& fine weather latter part the same
took down the try works took
in the spinnaker sent the fore
& main royal yards a loft
so ends this day

Sunday Augth 25 1861

Remarks on board Cambridge
With light air from the S.W.
fine weather Course W. by N.
middle & latter part the same saw
a whaling bark with child of bark
bound in saw 2 merchant brig
