All these 24 hours brisk breezes from South
steering on different tacks by the wind
under all sail so ends this day Lat 30.33
Long 26.42

Friday Nov 27th first part fine weather
wind S.E. heading S.W. middle the same
to the Palm so ends Lat 31.03 Long 26.41

Saturday Nov 28th first part fine weather
wind from west steering S.W. under all sail
latter wind N.W. so ends Lat 32.21 Long 27.25

Sunday Nov 29th first part fine breezes
from N.W. steering S.W. under all sail
middle strong breezes took in the light sail
latter strong winds from West took in the
sail & double reefed the top sails Lat 33.12
Long 27.12 W

Monday Nov 30th first moderate gale from
West lying to under a double reefed No. 1. Sail
middle moderate made sail steering South
latter fine weather wind S.W. heading S.E.
saw pinbacks so ends Lat 36.22 Long 25.2

Tuesday Dec 1st first and middle part
fine breezes from E to N.E. steering to the
E.S.E. by the wind latter strong winds from
N.N.E. to N.N.W. heading N.E. under
short sail so ends Lat " Long "

Wednesday Dec 3rd 1837
This day begins with strong gales from N.N.W.
lying to middle more moderate set the top
sails double reefed latter part strong winds
from North under short sail heading E.N.E.
so ends no obs

Thursday Dec 3rd first part strong winds
from N.N.W. heading E.N.E. under easy
sail middle strong winds from west steering
E.S.E. latter part wind South heading E.S.E. by
the wind under short sail Lat 36.15 South
Long 20.20 West

Friday Dec 4th all these 24 hours fine weather
wind S.E. heading on different tacks by the wind
under easy sail so ends Lat 36.15 South Long 19.41

Saturday Dec 5th all these 24 hours fine weather
fine breezes from N.E. to E.N.E. steering to the
Eastward by the wind under easy sail Lat 37.48
Long 17.50 W

Sunday Dec 6th first part strong winds from N.N.E.
steering East by the wind under all necessary
sail Lat 1 P.M. saw two right whales lowered without
success middle more ship to the N.W. latter more ship
to E.N.E. at 6 P.M. saw three right whales
lowered & picked one came aboard Lat 37.40 S
Long 17.28 West

Monday Dec 7th first part strong winds
from North steering E.N.E. by the wind at 4 P.M.
saw one right whale lowered without success middle
latter steering on diff. tacks by the wind
under easy sail Lat 37.26 South
Long 16.42 West
