

Tuesday Dec 8th 1857  
all these 24 hours strong breeze from the  
steering E. N. E. under all necessary sail  
jumbocks so made this day Lat 36.45 S  
Long 14.53 W

Wednesday Dec 9th this day begins with  
strong breeze from South steering E. S. E.  
middle part strong wind took in the S. S. sail  
and S. W. latter strong winds from South made  
E. S. E. westward sail Lat 36.33 South Long 13.32

Thursday Dec 10th first & middle strong  
from South heading E. P. E. under ready sail  
at 5 A.M. saw the Island of Tinian bearing  
S. by E. by compass 52 miles latter part  
of day in sight Lat 36.16 S Long 13.10 W

Friday Dec 11th all these 24 hours good  
breeze from the west steering from E. S. E. to  
S. S. E. the land & one sail in sight Lat 36.10 S  
Long 12.50 W

Saturday Dec 12th first part strong breeze  
from West spoke the Bark Pearl of  
the London Capt Jeffrey one whale middle  
latter fine weather land & one sail in  
sight Lat 36.17 S Long 11.11 W

Sunday Dec 13th all these 24 hours fine  
weather light breeze from N. N. W. steering  
S. S. W. under all sail the land in sight  
& the Pearl Lat 37.04 S Long 11.37 W

Monday Dec 14th 1857  
All these 24 hours fine weather and calm  
the land in sight & one sail Lat 37.06 S  
Long 11.44 West

Tuesday Dec 15th this day begins with a fine  
breeze from S. N. W. steering bearing 70 by S. Dis 215  
miles one sail in sight at 4 P.M. saw 3 right  
whales bore but without success at sundown  
took in sail Lat 37.09 S Long 11.44 West

Wednesday Dec 16th first part light breeze  
from S. N. W. steering N. E. the land & one sail  
in sight middle under short sail latter part  
wind N. W. steering East under all sail one  
sail in sight Lat 36.58 S Long 10.07 West

Thursday Dec 17th all these 24 hours strong  
winds from N. N. W. steering to the westward  
by the wind under any sail the Pearl in  
sight & two other sail Lat 36.24 S Long 10.49 W

Friday Dec 18th first & middle part strong wind  
from S. W. heading N. N. W. under short sail  
two sail in sight latter part light breeze from  
S. S. W. so ends under all sail Lat 36.12 South  
Long 11.44 West

Saturday Dec 19th first part strong wind  
from S. N. W. under short sail heading N. E.  
middle & latter moderate gale from N. W.  
bying to so ends Lat 36.40 S Long 11.40 W
