

Sunday March 28th 1838 Fish Bay
this day fine one watch on Liberty a Portuguese
man of war came in to anchor so ends

Monday March 29th fine weather one watch
on Liberty so ends this day

Tuesday March 30th this day fine one
boat fishing ship waiting for recruits

Wednesday March 31st all employed in
getting off recruits so ends

Thursday April 1st finished getting off
the recruits ready for sea waiting for wind

Friday April 2nd all these 24 hours
fine weather waiting for wind so ends

Saturday April 3rd all these 24 hours
fine weather ship waiting for wind at 8 P.M.
the Bark Steamer Capt Davis came in to
Anchor so ends this day

Sunday April 4th all this day fine
weather waiting for wind to go to sea

Monday April 5th all this day fine
weather waiting for wind to go to sea

Tuesday April 6th (Sun April) 1838
this day begins with fine weather & light breeze
from S.W. at 1 P.M. took the anchor and went
to sea at sundown land 15 miles dip shortened sail
saw blackfish lowered without success middle calm
at 6 A.M. saw blackfish lowered & got 4 & lost one
from alongside land 25 miles dip

Wednesday April 7th all these 24 hours fine
weather & light air from west employed in
clearing away & boiling out black blackfish
Lat 14.53 S Long 110.29 E

Thursday April 8th this day light breeze from
S.W. at 4 P.M. saw blackfish lowered and got
three heard them away & boiled them out
Lat 14.30 S Long 110.33 E

Friday April 9th first part light air
from S.W. & strong W.N.W. middle calm latter
light air from E.S.E. so ends Lat 14.40 S
Long 110.57 East

Saturday April 10th all these 24 hours fine
breeze from S.W. saw blackfish and got one
Lat 14.58 S Long 110.38 E

Sunday April 11th first part fine breeze
from South saw blackfish got one took him
onboard & boiled the two out middle wind
S.W. & backing west at 6 A.M. saw a large
whale at 7 A.M. lowered at 8 the L. boat struck
& at twelve over the L. boat bent on the line
at 9 the whale turned up at 10 took him to
the ship & rose the putting gear Lat 14.58 S
Long 110 East
