

Sunday April 12th 1888
 This day begins with strong winds from South
 raged with a large whale alongside at 1 P.M.
 Commenced cutting backed fluke chanes twice for
 Chane & Chane drop at dark lashed down and
 got supper middle raged at 6 A.M. kept the
 ship before the wind & commenced cutting
 at noon got the head off so sails Lat 14.19 S
 Long 8.38 E

Tuesday April 13th first part strong wind
 from S.P.W. & raged employed in cutting at
 finished the body middle raged at 8 P.M.
 Commenced taking in the gunk so sails
 Lat 14.01 S Long 8.40 E

Wednesday April 14th first part strong breeze
 from S.W. employed in getting in the case &
 tailing it at 6 P.M. finished and set the water
 middle commenced boiling latter part wind &
 heading W.S.W. employed in boiling Lat 13.48 S
 Long 8.45 E

Thursday April 15th this day begins with fine
 weather wind S.P.W. heading W. employed in
 boiling middle at 6 P.M. set the watch lat
 all hands employed in boiling so sails heading W.
 Lat 13.31 S Long 8.48 E

Friday April 16th first part wind S.P.W.
 Employed in boiling at 6.30 P.M. at the water
 latter part under short sail employed in
 boiling so sails Lat 13.46 S Long 8.50 E

Saturday April 17th first part strong breeze from
 S.E. raged heading W. employed in boiling at
 finished latter strong breeze heading W.S.W.

Sunday April 18th 1888
 all these 24 hours strong winds from
 South steering on diff. tacks by the wind
 under short sail so sails Lat 13.46 S
 Long 7.05 E

Monday April 19th first part strong wind
 from S.P.W. heading S.P.E. under short
 sail middle & latter the same Lat 13.26 S
 Long 8.05 E

Tuesday April 20th first & middle part strong
 winds from S.P.W. heading S.P.E. under easy sail
 latter moderate employed in storing down oil
 Lat 13.38 S Long 7.25 E

Wednesday April 21st first part fine
 weather wind S.P.W. heading S.E. employed in
 storing down latter tacked ship to the west
 so sails storing down the oil Lat 13.28 S
 Long 7.29 E

Thursday April 22nd all these 24 hours
 strong breeze & fine weather from S. to S.W.
 steering on different tacks by the wind
 under easy sail Lat 13.47 S Long 8.32 E

Friday April 23rd all this day strong
 breeze from S.P.W. to W.S.W. steering on diff.
 tacks by the wind under easy sail Lat 14.13 S
 Long 7.34 E

Saturday April 24th first part strong breeze
 from S.P.W. steering N.W. & middle under
 short sail heading W. latter steering
 N.W. with all sail Lat 13.48 S Long 6.42 East
