

Remarks On Board Bark Keoka Saturday July 10th 1853
 begins with fine weather at anchor at 3 P.M.
 took the anchor & drifted with the current
 to the S.W. middle calm latter fine
 breeze from S.W. steering in for the land

Sunday July 11th this day begins with fine
 breeze from S.W. steering in for the land at 6 P.M.
 came to anchor spoke the Cornelia Capt
 Spooner 12 months out 320 Tons at 4 P.M.
 took the anchor and steered down the
 coast saw one sail at anchor so ends

Monday July 12th first part calm
 middle and latter light airs from S.W.
 steering down the coast heading N.W.

Tuesday July 13th all these 24 hours
 light fair and calm from S.W. steering
 N.W. in Co with the H. Augusta land
 distance 8 miles so ends Lat 4.04 S
 Long 14.40 E

Wednesday July 14th fine weather light
 airs from S.W. steering N.W. & N.W.
 saw humpbacks lowered without success
 and the Helen in company Lat 3.21 South
 Long 14.10 East

Thursday July 15th first part light breeze
 from S.W. steering N.W. middle calm
 latter thick weather saw a humpback &
 lowered the L. Boat shot a bomb into him
 and killed him at 11 A.M. took him to
 the ship so ends getting ready for cutting



Remarks On Board Bark Keoka Friday July 16th 1853
 first part light airs from S.W. employed in
 cutting a humpback saw two more lowered
 without affect middle and latter thick
 steering N.W. in Co with H. Augusta
 Lat 2.20 South Long 14.04

Saturday July 17th fine pleasant weather
 wind S.W. steering S.W. employed in
 boiling saw humpbacks lowered the Helen
 boats struck and drew middle & latter
 steering N.W. at 7 A.M. finished boiling

Sunday July 18th all these 24 hours fine
 breezes from S.W. running down along the
 land chased humpbacks land is 10 miles
 Lat 1.48 South

Monday July 19th brisk breeze from S.W. boats
 chasing humpbacks at 3 P.M. came on board
 and stood into Cape Lopez and came to
 anchor 3 miles from shore at 6 A.M. took the
 anchor and stood out in Co with the H. Augusta
 saw whales lowered the L. Boat struck at 12 took
 him to the ship Cape Lopez 12 miles S is
 No obs

Tuesday July 20th brisk breeze from S.W.
 at 1 P.M. commenced cutting at & finished
 middle steering N by west latter the same
 employed in cutting blubber saw blackfish
 so ends the H. Augusta in Co
 Lat 1.16 S Long 14.44 East
