

Remarks On Board Bark Keoka Tuesday Aug 3<sup>rd</sup> 1858  
This day strong breezes from S. & W. boats  
cruising the S. boat captured with the  
sail but got picked up after lying in  
the water for three or four hours

Wednesday Aug 4<sup>th</sup> this day strong breezes  
from S. & W. the boats on board employed in  
stowing down oil so ends this day

Thursday Aug 5<sup>th</sup> this day fine weather  
at 4 P.M. took the anchor at 7 P.M. came  
to anchor at Goat Island in 5 fathoms  
later part boats off cruising for whales

Friday Aug 6<sup>th</sup> fine weather boats started  
at 6 A.M. took the anchor and stood  
to the North under all sail

Saturday Aug 7<sup>th</sup> all these 24 hours strong  
breezes from S. & W. stirring from S.E. to  
N.E. by 8 under all sail so ends this day

Sunday Aug 8<sup>th</sup> begins with strong breezes  
S.W. stirring for the Island of Princes in  
company with the K. Augusta mistle  
fine land 20 miles at 10 A.M. came  
to anchor at Princes in 8 fathoms

Monday August 9<sup>th</sup> strong breezes from  
S.W. the Dr. Franklin's whale latter  
boats down for humpbacks at 8 A.M. the  
S. boat struck a humpback & the iron drew  
so ends the ship at anchor

Remarks On Board Bark Keoka Tuesday Aug 10<sup>th</sup> 1858  
This day fine pleasant weather boats cruising  
for whales so ends this day at anchor

Wednesday Aug 11<sup>th</sup> strong breezes from South  
got the ship under way to work up to the weather  
side of the island after a while at 2 P.M. came  
to anchor in 13 fathoms 8 miles from the whale  
middle squally latter underway beating up to the  
whale so ends

Thursday Aug 12<sup>th</sup> fine weather waiting for  
the whale to come up at 6 P.M. the whale  
came up & took him to the ship amidst raising  
at 6 A.M. commenced cutting at 10 finished  
& commenced boiling at noon came to anchor

Friday Aug 13<sup>th</sup> fine pleasant weather  
employed in boiling at 9 A.M. finished boiling  
so ends boats cruising

Saturday Aug 14<sup>th</sup> this day fine weather  
boats off cruising for whales so ends at anchor

Sunday Aug 15<sup>th</sup> these 24 hours strong breezes  
from S. & W. boats off after whales so  
ends this day at anchor

Monday Aug 16<sup>th</sup> strong breezes from  
S.W. at anchor two boats cruising and one  
on board stowing down oil

Tuesday Aug 17<sup>th</sup> moderate breeze from S.W.  
at anchor two boats cruising & one on  
board stowing down oil so ends
