Remarks On Board Bark Beecha Wednesday Aug 18th
First & middle part fine boats cruising
latter part rising so ends

Thursday Aug 19th this day strong breeze
from S.W. & equally boats off cruising
so ends this day

Friday Aug 20th at anchor boats cruising
for whales so ends fine weather

Saturday Aug 21st begins with light breeze
at 6 A.M. took the anchor to work
to the windward after a whale so ends
under all sail

Sunday Aug 22nd fine weather ship under
all sail at 3 P.M. took the whale
alongside and hauled it in & anchored &
commenced cutting at 10 P.M. finished
latter boiling hauled down after whales

Monday Aug 23rd first & middle
fine boats cruising latter this scene
finished boiling

Tuesday Aug 24th fine pleasant weather
boats clock got a whale in co with
H. Augusta so ends this day

Wednesday Aug 25th this day fine
weather boats down cruising for whales

Thursday Aug 26th at anchor ^{two boats}
off after whales & one on board stowing
down sail so ends this day

Remarks On Board Bark Beecha Aug 27th 1838
All these 24 hours fine pleasant weather
two boats cruising and one on board
stowing down sail so ends

Saturday Aug 28th begins with fine
weather boats cruising at 3 P.M. one boat
came to the ship with the 3rd mate of the
Helen Augusta and his crew he had been
fast to a whale and got store of one man
killed the other boats saved the whale at
5 P.M. got the ship under way to go to the
whale at 6 P.M. came to anchor in 15 fathoms
latter took the anchor & worked up to the
whale and came to anchor in 12 fathoms

Sunday Aug 29th at anchor waiting for
the whale to rise so ends fine weather

Monday Aug 30th fine weather at 6 A.M.
got the ship under way to take the whale
at 10 got him to the ship & commenced
cutting so ends this day

Tuesday Aug 31st begins with fine weather
Employed in cutting at 3 P.M. finished at
5 P.M. came to anchor in 12 fathoms and
commenced boiling so ends boiling

Wednesday Sept 1st 1838 -
begins with fine weather employed in boiling
at 6 P.M. finished at 8 A.M. got under way to
work up to another bay so ends under all
sail
