

Remarks On Board Bk. Peckha Tuesday Sept 21st 1858
Began with light breezes from S.W. at
anchor at 6 A.M. took the anchor & com-
working up to west so ends under all sail
the Helen Augusta is now going home

Wednesday Sept 22nd began with light air
from S.W. at 3 P.M. came to anchor in
16 fathoms of water middle fine latter took
the anchor again and commenced working
up to West bay

Thursday Sept 23rd fine breezes from S.W.
under all sail at 3 P.M. came to anchor
in west bay latter boats cruising for whales

Friday Sept 24th this day begins with fine
weather at anchor employed in
getting up Shooks latter boats cruising

Saturday Sept 25th this day begins with fine
weather boats cruising for whales middle
raining latter employed in getting off water

Sunday Sept 26th this day raining weather
at anchor in west bay getting off water

Monday Sept 27th at anchor getting off water
and stowing it down so ends

Tuesday Sept 28th at anchor getting water &
stowing it down so ends

Wednesday Sept 29th fine weather at
anchor at 7 A.M. took the anchor to go to
Sea so ends under all sail the Bark
Tropic Bird in company

Remarks On Board Bk. Peckha Sunday Nov 29th 1858
These 24 hours fine weather & light breezes
from W.P.W. heading South by the wind
under all sail so ends Lat 13. 14 South
Long 10. 48 East

Tuesday Nov 30th first & middle part
light breezes from S.W. steering S.E. latter
part steering E by S & S under all sail
so ends this day Lat 13. 18 South
Long 12. 00 East

Bark Peckha Wednesday Dec 1st 1858
first part light breeze from west steering
E by S at 1 P.M. saw the land bearing
S.E. by compass Dis 25 miles middle on
different tracks by the wind the main
yard aback latter saw blackfish broad
got none so ends calm land Dis 6 miles
Lat 13. 17 South

Thursday Dec 2nd fine weather & light
airs from W.P.W. steering in for Equinaena
at 5 P.M. came to anchor in 17 fathoms
of water in Equinaena bay middle &
latter fine at anchor so ends

Friday Dec 3rd all these 24 hours fine
weather at anchor in Equinaena
So Ends This day

Saturday Dec 4th fine pleasant weather
at anchor waiting for recruits

Sunday Dec 5th fine weather employed
in getting potatoes at 2 P.M. the boat went
ashore and four men run away at 9 P.M.
went ashore and caught them & brought
them on board so ends this day
