Wednesday Jan 5th Strong winds from
 South on different tacks by the wind
 under short sail Lat 21.38 South
 Long 9.53 East

Thursday Jan 6th brisk breeze from South
 steering N.E. by E under short sail
 Lat 20.56 S Long 10.08 E

Friday Jan 7th first part fine breeze
 from South steering N.E. by E middle
 later by the wind under all sail
 Lat 21.20 S Long 9.49 E

Saturday Jan 8th light breeze from
 S.W. heading S.E. by the wind under
 all sail. nothing in sight Lat 21.20 S
 Long 10.08 E

Sunday Jan 9th light airs from S
 heading west by the wind under all
 sail so ends this day Lat 21.33 S
 Long 9.31 E

Monday Jan 10th all these 24 hours
 fine pleasant weather & light airs
 from South steering on different tacks
 by the wind under all sail saw
 plenty of Porpoises so ends this day
 Lat 21.50 South
 Long 9.40 East

Remarks On Board Bk. Keckwa Tuesday Jan 11th 1854
 first part light airs from South heading
 E.S.E. at 3 P.M. saw two Sp whales at 4 P.M.
 the boats at 6 the L. boat struck at 7 P.M.
 took him alongside middle fine rave
 the cutting falls at 6 A.M. commenced
 cutting at 7 A.M. saw a Sp whale going
 N.E. did not lower so ends cutting one
 sail in sight Lat 21.29 South



Wednesday Jan 12th this day begins
 begins with fine weather wind South employed
 in cutting at 7.30 P.M. finished middle
 strong breeze at 6 A.M. commenced
 boiling later strong winds from S.E.
 heading S.W. under short sail
 Lat 21.15 S Long 8.36 E

Thursday Jan 13th Strong winds
 from South heading S.W. by W under
 short sail employed in boiling
 Lat 21.29 South
 Long 8.56 East

Friday Jan 14th all these 24 hours
 strong winds from South steering
 on diff tacks by the wind under
 short sail employed in boiling
 Lat 21.33 S Long 8.30 E

Saturday Jan 15th fine breeze from
 South heading E.S.E. at 9 P.M. finished
 boiling so ends Lat 21.16 S Long 9.00 E
