fine breeze from South at 6 P.m spoke
Bark Globe Capt. Tripp 5 1/2 months out
380 Spurn so ends in Co with the Globe
Lat 21.03 S Long 10.21 E

Thursday Feb 3rd fine pleasant weather
& light airs from South in Co with the
Globe lett her heave two casks of water
so ends heading to E.S.E by the wind
Lat 20.83 S Long 10.46 E

Friday Feb 4th fine weather & light
breezes from South steering on diff
tacks by the wind one sail in sight
Lat 21.03 S Long 10.30 E

Saturday Feb 5th all these 24 hours
strong breezes from South heading to the
westward by the wind one sail in
sight so ends Lat 21.31 South
Long 9.04 East

all this day strong breezes from South
steering on different tacks by the wind
under easy sail Lat 21.26 South
Long 9.24 East

Monday Feb 7th strong breeze from South
heading E.S.E two sail in sight so ends
Lat 21.18 S Long 10.12

Tuesday February 8th begins with fine weather
wind South at 4 P.m spoke the Globe
middle & latter fine six sail in sight the
globe struck a whale & he took the line
Lat 21.30 S Long 9.53 East

Wednesday Feb 9th fine breeze from South
& cloudy weather five sail in sight
steering on diff tacks by the wind
under all sail Lat 21.38 S Long 9.38

Thursday Feb 10th begins with strong
breezes from South at 2 P.m spoke the
Brig Pavilion of Holmes Hole Capt.
Adams 7 months out 80 Spurn so ends
heading E.S.E Lat 21.19 S Long 10.06 E

Friday Feb 11th all these 24 hours
strong winds from South heading
on different tacks by the wind the
Pavilion in sight to the leeward
so ends under short sail Lat 21.30 S
Long 9.28 E
