steering on different tacks by the
wind Lat 6° 36' South Long 9° 25' East

Thursday June 9th light breeze
from South steering on diff
tacks by the wind Lat 6° 44' South
Long 9° 00' East

Friday June 10th wind South
steering on diff tacks Lat 6° 40' S
Long 8° 33' E

Saturday June 11th fine breeze
from South steering on different tacks
Lat 7° 03' South
Long 8° 54' East

Sunday June 12th fine weather
light breeze from South steering on
different tacks so ends Lat 7° 15' S
Long 8° 23' East

Remarks On Board Monday June 13th 1839
fine weather and a light breeze from
South heading E.S.E. by the wind
so ends nothing in sight Lat 7° 10' South
Long 9° 10' East

Tuesday June 14th fine pleasant
weather light breeze from South
steering on different tacks at 3
P.M. spoke the Brig Pavilion Capt
A. Lums 2500 Tons Lat 7° 10' South
Long 9° 10' East

Wednesday June 15th nearly calm
sailing with the Pavilion
Lat 7° 00' S Long 10° 20' E

Thursday June 16th light breeze from
South heading E.S.E. two sail in
sight so ends Lat 7° 04' South
Long 11° 28' East

Friday June 17th light breeze from
South heading E.S.E. Lat 6° 17' S
Long 12° 00' East

Saturday June 18th fine weather
the Capt in sight and I ship
steering down the coast at night
halled by the wind heading off
shore Lat 6° 52' South Long 12° 20' E

Sunday June 19th fine weather wind
from South steering S at 6 P.M. came to
anchor off Congo river and so ends
Lat 6° 15' South
Long 12° 08' East
