

Monday August 1st 1859

fine weather two whales alongside at 8 A.M. the fluke chain parted & one whale sunk at 5 A.M. commenced cutting at 10 finished cutting and started the works at 11 A.M. left go the big anchor to stop her from dragging so end

Tuesday Aug 2nd this day begins with this day begins with fine weather boiling at 7 A.M. finished the other whale came up commenced cutting him in at 3 P.M. the L. Boat lowered and picked up a dead whale theropic Bird in sight at 7 P.M. finished cutting so ends this day boiling

Wednesday Aug 3rd fine pleasant weather employed in boiling two sail in sight

Thursday Aug 4th Strong breezes from S.W. boiling at 10 A.M. finished one sail in sight

Friday Aug 5th fine weather all hands employed in stowing down oil one sail in sight

Saturday Aug 6th fine pleasant weather employed in stowing down oil

Sunday Aug 7th fine weather at 1 P.M. took the anchor at 3 loosed the boats the waist boat struck at 4 took him along side & cutt him in watch employed in cutting up blubber

Monday Aug 8th 1859

fine weather at 9 A.M. lowered the boats the ship under way at 12 the S. Boat struck & sunk him at 3 P.M. the ship came to anchor 2 miles from the whale the S. Boat lying by the whale



Tuesday Aug 9th fine weather ship at anchor one boat lying by the whale Cooper setting up shooks so ends

Wednesday Aug 10th fine weather at 8 a.m. lalled the whale up at 9 took him along side & commenced cutting at 5 P.M. finished & started the works so ends boiling

Thursday Aug 11th fine pleasant weather employed in boiling one sail in sight so ends this day

Friday Aug 12th fine weather at anchor boiling at 9 A.M. finished so ends this day

Saturday Aug 13th at 7 A.M. got underway & stood in shore and came to anchor in 13 fathoms the capt. went on board of the bark Globe

Sunday Aug 14th fine two boats chasing whales the boats crew on board stowing down oil
