

Remarks On Board Friday Nov 18th
 First part light breezes from S.E.
 heading S.S.W. middle part raining
 latter fine breeze from E.N.E. heading
 North one sail in sight Lat 23.55 South
 Long 86.51 W

Saturday Nov 19th fine pleasant
 weather wind E.N.E. heading to the
 N. at 9 A.M. saw 8 sperm whales at
 10 loosed the boats at noon the S. boat
 struck so ends one boat fast
 Lat 22.01 South



Sunday Nov 20th fine weather &
 light breezes from E.N.E. heading S.
 at 1 P.M. took the whale alongside &
 commenced cutting at 3 finished
 at night took in sail middle fine
 at 5 A.M. saw large whales loosed the
 S. boat struck and the whale took
 the line chased him until 10 A.M.
 then came on board & got breakfast
 then loosed for the whale again so
 ends boats chasing the fast whale

Monday Nov 21st first part
 light breeze from E. boats after the
 fast whale at 5 P.M. came on board
 & started the works middle fine
 heading S.E. at 7 A.M. saw sperm
 whales at 9 loosed the S. boat struck &
 got stove all to pieces & lost one man
 Andrew Gorgon 28 years of age Native
 of the ~~West~~ West Indies the other
 boats saved the whale cow & calf killed
 a loss one & he sunk Lat 23.22 South
 Long 87.48 W

Remarks On Board Tuesday Nov 22nd 1859
 First part strong breezes from N.E.
 at 3 P.M. got the whale alongside &
 commenced cutting at finished and
 took in sail middle strong breezes
 latter the same employed in clearing
 away the head so ends under short
 sail Lat 23.28 S Long 87.08 W

Wednesday Nov 23rd first part
 strong winds from N.N.E. under
 short sail middle a moderate
 gale from N. at 10 P.M. the deck pot
 fetched away and broke Chutes
 Brownells leg latter part the same
 heading to the Eastward by the wind

Thursday Nov 24th first part
 light breezes from N.W. heading
 N.N.E. middle & latter the same
 at 7 A.M. started the works so
 ends boiling Lat 23.22 South
 Long 87.48 West

Friday Nov 25th all these 24
 hours fine breezes from S. steering
 on different tacks at 8 A.M.
 finished boiling two sail in sight
 Lat 22.28 South
 Long 85.18 West

Saturday Nov 26th this day fine
 breezes from S.E. steering S.W.
 under all sail so ends saw two
 sail steering North Lat
 Long 87.18 W
