Lawson 4.3 days out clean middle
fine latter the same wind

Friday Dec 23rd all these 24
hours fine pleasant weather &
fine breezes from N.E. Steering
on diff^r tacks Lat 22.52 South
Long 36.39 West

Saturday Dec 24th light breezes
from N.E. heading E. some two
