part fine breezes from E heading
N.W.E. latter Steering N.W. W
Lat 23.33 S Long 36.41

Saturday Jan 14th first part light
winds from E.N.E. Steering S.W. at
sight took in sail and luffed
to the wind heading N.W. daylight
headed N.W. W under all sail

Sunday Jan 15th Strong breezes
from N.W.E. Steering on diff. tacks
under all sail Lat 24.32 South
Long 38.19 W

Monday Jan 16th first & middle
