First part Strong breeze from N.E.
Steering W at sundown luffed to
the wind heading N.W. latter
turning N.W. Lat 25.23 South
Long 40.47 West

Wednesday Jan 18th Strong breezes
from N.E. Steering on different
tacks so ends Lat 25.48 South
Long 40.34 West

Thursday Jan 19th fine breezes
from N.E. Steering on diff. tacks
saw one sail. Lat 25.38 South
Long 41.12 West

Friday Jan 20th fine weather
and fine breezes from N.E.
Steering on different tacks latter
part Steering S.W. under all
sail so ends this day

Saturday Jan 21st this day begins
with fine breezes from N.E. Steering
S.W. at sundown took in the light
sails & luffed to the wind heading
S.E. latter part Steering South saw
two sails Lat 27.04 S. Long 41.25

Sunday Jan 22nd At these 24
hours Strong breezes from E.S.E.
heading S by the wind under
short sail Spoke the English
Bark Lirap of Stockton
Lat 28.13 South
Long 41.43 W

by the wind Employed in washing
Ship so ends this day Lat 20.37 S
Long 8.57 W

Thursday March 15th first part
light breezes from S.E. heading
E.N.E. Middle and latter wind
from S.E. to E.S.E. heading E.N.E.
Lat 20.13 South
Long 7.37 West

Friday March 16th all these 24
hours light breezes from S.E. Ship
heading E.N.E. by the wind so
ends this day Lat
Long 7.29 West

Saturday March 17th light breezes
from E.S.E. to S.E. Steering on diff.
tacks by the wind Lat 18.09 South
Long 7.10 West

Sunday March 18th all this day
light breezes from S.E. heading
E.N.E. saw two sails Lat 17.33 S
Long 6.24 W

Monday March 19th fine breezes
from S.E. Steering E.N.E. by the wind
at 6 A.M. made the Island of
St. Helena so ends several sail
in sight
