point of the compass steering
N. N. W. Lat 4.03 North
Long 19.47 West

Wednesday May 2nd this day
begins with light airs from W. N. W.
heading N saw one seal
middle & latter part baffling
winds and raining

Thursday May 3rd light airs
from all around the house
& sailing heading to the North
when we could Lat 4.52 North
Long 19.41 West

Friday May 4th light airs from
the N. ship on diff. tracks saw
one seal Lat 4.59 North
Long 20.38 West

Saturday May 5th light airs
from N heading W. N. W. spoke
the Brig Danell of Limerick
28 days from Glasgow
saw seals under all sail Lat 4.44
Long 20.47

Sunday May 6th light breezes
from N heading N. N. W. one
seal in sight saw seals
under all sail Lat 4.54 N
Long 21.26 W

Remarks On Board Monday May 7th 1860
This day light airs from N
steering on diff. tracks saw two
tails saw seals Lat 4.55 North
Long 22.10 West

Tuesday May 8th light airs
from N. heading on diff. tracks
saw blackfish got two seals
under all sail

Wednesday May 9th light airs
from N. heading N. N. W. sailed
out the blackfish Lat 5.28 North
Long 23.46 West

Thursday May 10th light breezes
from N. E. heading N. N. W. spoke
the Ship Wizard King of New-
York from London bound to
Bombay Lat 5.33 North
Long 24.16 West

Friday May 11th first part light
airs from N. E. heading N. N. W.
middle raining latter fine two
seals in sight Lat 6.02 N
Long 25.00 W

Saturday May 12th light air
from E heading N under all
sail employed in caping the
reefs saw seals Lat 6.40 North
Long 25.06 West
