All these 24 hours light breeze from
S heading W.S.W. Lat 38° 09' North
Long 37° 55' West

Monday July 2nd light breezes
from S and fine weather Ship
heading W.S.W. under all sail
Lat 37° 31' N Long 39° 11'

Tuesday July 3rd fine weather
and light breezes from S.S.W.
heading on different tacks by the
wind so ends this day Lat 37° 20' N
Long 38° 32'

Wednesday July 4th fine breezes
from S.S.W. heading S.E. by the
wind spoke the Schooner Watchman
of Amherst port 10 months out
450 bbls of R. B. F. oil Lat 36° 59'
Long 36° 52'

Thursday July 5th first part fine
breezes from S.S.W. heading S.E.
middle part raining & some
thunder latter fine Lat "

Friday July 6th Strong breezes
from S heading to the E.S.E. spoke
the bark Preak & brig Amelia of
Mattapoisett Lat 36° 08' N
Long 35° 40' W

Remarks On Board Monday July 30th 1800
Fine weather & light breezes from S.E.
Steering W.S.W. two sails in sight
so ends this day

Tuesday July 31st light breezes from
S. Steering W.S.W. one sail in sight
Lat 40° 44' N Long 35° 57'

Wednesday Aug 1st Strong breezes
from S.E. Steering W. spoke the
Elizabeth of Westport Lat 40° 24' North
Long 37° 50' West

Thursday Aug 2nd fine weather
and strong breezes from S.S.E. Steering
E by the wind the Elizabeth in Co.
so ends this day Lat 41° 40' North
Long 36° 53' West

Friday Aug 3rd fine breezes from
S.E. heading E.S.E. by the wind the
Elizabeth in Co. so ends under all sail
Lat 42° 37' N Long 36° 13' W

Saturday Aug 4th fine weather and
a fine breeze from S. to S.S.E.
heading to the Eastward spoke
the bark Annawan so ends the
Annawan & Elizabeth in sight
Lat 42° 41' North
Long 34° 55' West
