

Remarks On Board Sunday Aug 5th 1860
first part fine breeze from S.E.
heading E middle of latter wind
S.W. steering S.E. Lat 42.13 North
Long 83.38 West

Monday Aug 6th all these light
breezes from W steering S.P.W.
under all sail by ends three
sails in sight Lat 41.29 N
Long 82.46 West

Tuesday Aug 7th fine breeze from
S.E. steering on different tracks
by the wind Lat 41.32 North
Long 82.11 West

Wednesday Aug 8th Strong breeze
from N.E. and thick steering on
different tracks under short sail
Spoke the Ship *Demona* of N.B.
Capt Bates 20 days out for us.

Thursday Aug 9th Strong breeze
from N.W. heading N.W. under
short sail Lat 41.12 North
Long 83.38 West

Friday Aug 10th Strong breeze
from N heading N.W. by the
wind under short sail
Lat 41.25 North
Long 84.48 West

Remarks On Board Saturday Aug 11th 1860
This day begins with fine breeze from
N.E. heading N.W. under all sail at
sundown took in the light sails middle
fine at 6 A.M. saw a large Sperm
whale at 7 bred the boats at 9 the
S. Boat struck at 11 took the whale
alongside so ends

Sunday Aug 12th This day begins with
fine weather wind N.E. employed in cutting
at 6 P.M. lashed down for the night
at daylight commenced cutting spoke
the Elizabeth's boards cutting Lat 40.52 N
Long 85.09 W

Monday Aug 13th fine weather wind
E.N.E. heading N at 4 P.M. finished
bailing the case at 10 P.M. commenced
bailing latter part fine employed in
bailing so ends Lat 41.06 North
Long 85.33 West

Tuesday Aug 14th all these 24
hours fine breeze from E.N.E.
heading N by the wind employed
in bailing I got my foot scalded
in a deck pot of hot oil so
now I am off of duty for one
month at the least
