fine weather & light air from
S.E. steering S by W 14 sails in
sight employed in painting
to ends this day Lat 37.33 North
Long 38.03 West

Tuesday Sept 18th first & middle
part calms latter light breezes from
S.E. & steering S by W under
all sail

Wednesday Sept 19th first part
light air from S.E. & steering
S by W middle & latter fine
breezes from W.S.W. to ends
this day Lat 39.03 Long 39.08

Thursday Sept 20th first and
middle part strong breezes from
West & equally steering S under
light sail latter light breezes
from N.W. heading N.E.
Lat 39.56 Long 39.11

Friday Sept 21st this day begins
with fine breezes from W.S.W.
steering N. middle the wind from
all quarters latter part strong breeze
from N.E. to N.W. steering W.S.W. by
N under all present sail
Bound Round Lat 40.49 North
Long 40.27 West

Remarks On Board Saturday Sept 22nd 1860
This day begins with strong winds
from E.N.E. steering N.W. by N and the
more moderate wind the latter part
fine breezes from S.E. steering N.W.
under all sail Lat 41.37 North
Long 43.04 West

Sunday Sept 23rd first part fine
breezes from S.E. steering N.W. middle part
wind S.E. & latter fine breezes from S.W.
steering N.W. by W best the royals so
ends under all sail Lat 42.08 North
Long 45.23 West

Monday Sept 24th all three 24
hours fine breezes from S.E. & steering
W.S.W. under all sail
saw two sails steering to the E
to ends this day No logs

Tuesday Sept 25th this day begins
with light breezes from S.E. & steering
W.S.W. one sail in sight middle
part rainy latter fine Lat 42.54 N
Long 47.22

Wednesday Sept 26th first & middle
part strong breezes from S.W. steering
W.S.W. under all sail latter part
took in the fly jib & topgallant
sails to ends one sail in sight
Lat 43.10 North
Long 49.06 West
