Journal Of A Voyage Of Bark Marcella

Tuesday April 25th 1865

Fine weather and light breezes from and S.W. all hands on board took the Anchor working out discharged the Pilot at 12 o'clock at night under Calm No Obs

Wednesday April 26th

Commenced with Calm and thick fog took a look at 7 pm lit up saw Black Island. Saw three lights the same time began with strong breeze from S and S.W. No Obs

Thursday April 27th Lat 40 28 N Long 69 42 W 2.30 pm

Commenced with strong breezes and Eads with light air from the South Lat 38 59 N Long 68 20 W

Friday April 28th Commenced with light breeze from S.W. to S.S.W. Now getting along busy looking for things

Saturday April 29th Commenced with light air and a head wind Lat 38 43 N Long 67 22 W

Sunday April 30th Commenced with fresh breezes from S.W. and S. board S.W. & easy fair saw 2 seals Lat 37 48 N Long 66 20 W

Monday May 1st

Commenced with strong breezes from S cant head anywhere nor go any where

Tuesday May 2nd Strong breeze and bad weather Lat 37 54 N Long 61 07 W

Wednesday May 3rd

Strong Gale from S and S.W. Laying to under close reefed top sails

Lat 38 10 N Long 59 30 30 W

Thursday 4th

Strong Gale handed for 24 hours fair heavy rain squalls at 4 pm under all sail away and struck N.W. and died away calm No Obs
