Saturday May 6th Commenced with light airs
and calms lowered down to practice the booms
and such a breeze set I never saw ends with
strong breezes from W.S.W. thick. No Obs

Sunday May 7th Commenced with strong
breezes and thick haze weather from S.W. double
reefed Top Sails saw Blackfish Lat 34.55 N

Long 58.52 W

Monday May 8th Light airs and haze
from the Westward the Watcher employed putting
in chafing gear and fitting things generally

Lat 35.09 N Long 59.05.45 W

Tuesday May 9th Commenced with strong
breezes and bad weather Nothing in sight
Wednesday May 10th Moderate to strong Blackfish
hazy

Thursday May 11th Commenced with fine clear
weather from S.W. all sail looking but in vain
cant see any Whales yet Lat 35.13 N Long 60.28.15 W

Friday May 12th Fine weather and light breezes
from S by the wind opposite tack saw a Harkness
fin back & Blackfish under hope to see Whales soon

Lat 35.51 N Long 61.34 W

Saturday May 13th Fine weather from S by the wind opposite
tack. Notho but saw under fin back in sight

Lat 35.58 N Long 59.59 W

Sunday May 14th Fine weather Nothing in sight
toward the boat to practice Lat 35.52 N Long 61.01.15 W

Monday May 15th Fine weather and light breezes
from the Southward saw one fair employed busily
saw Lat 30.08 N Long 60.40.45 W

Tuesday May 16th Fine weather and light breezes from
S and S.W. two sails in sight No Whales
Lat 36.23 N Long 59.53.50 W
