any chance to get any thing and are
going to give it up in a few days at a new

Sept 2nd All then 24 hours light baffling
winds chiefly from the Westward

Lat 40.36 N Long 33.06 W

Sept 3rd Strong breeze from W.S.W. course
S.S.W. all sail Saw 2 Sails

Lat 39.57 N Long 31.14 W

Sept 4th Strong breeze from N.W. at 7 am
exchanged Long with an English Brig
found we was out of the Way to the East
20 miles, corrected it by rising Steamer for 24 hours
made the Land at 4 pm headed off shore

Sept 5th ^{and heavy rain. Squally} Strong Gale from S.S.W. heading
W and W.S.W. close reefed Main & Sail

Lat 39.33 N Long 29.31 W

Sept 6th All this day Strong Gale and sea
thick squally from N.W. wind down to the leeward
of Flores and hove to under 2 close reefed Sails

Sept 7th Commenced with strong breeze and
fine weather once light and steering S.W. then
sail at 8 pm Saw Pico bearing S.W.

Lat 38.45 N Long 29.41 W

Sept 8th Commenced with light breezes once strong
from S.W. at 4 pm came to anchor in Bayall

Sept 10th At 4 pm got underway, thick and hazy
from the Eastward

Sept 17th Light breeze and calm
