Oct 10<sup>th</sup> squally

In Lat 7<sup>th</sup> it had a calm 15 or 16 days

Long 20 or 22 W crossed the line in 24.30 W

took the breeze in but 3 or 4 days strong breeze

and squally well to the south crossed the line

the 3<sup>rd</sup> of Nov beyond the Trustees near 18
