Wednesday April 16th begins fair pleasant & steering
 N & E, middle and latter calm saw
 B. F. and Esquimaux without the forecast
 bent the old cutter one painted the chains
 Lat 28.13 N
 Long 61.15 W

Thursday April 17th begins light southerly
 air cleared to W - N^W at night shortened
 sail set - Boat crew watches one sail in sight
 middle and latter wind from N^W latter steady N^W but
 pleasant
 Lat 29.08 Long 60.24

Friday April 18th
 this day begins fair wind NW all sail set
 cruising to the N^W night shortened sail &
 middle and latter light fair air & calm
 so ends this day Lat 29.39 N
 Long 59.53 W

Saturday April 19th begins light S^W wind
 steering N^W middle and latter over air
 and calm so ends today Lat 29.46
 Long 58.29

Sunday April 20th begins light southerly air steering
 eastward night when topsails, middle and latter
 pleasant & wind from S^W started by 5th and
 perpendicular luffing; so ends Lat 30.40 N
 Long 58.30 W

Monday April 21st begins fair weather wind S^W heading
 by N & middle strong winds latter fair
 wind S & S^W 1 sail Lat 31.14
 Long 57.58
